

Journal continued

Mon May 10th This day gentle breeze from South & fair weather. finished boiling at 10 A.M. saw Black fish also saw a Whale just before sunset. at noon set the Foreail At sunset more ship to S.W. & took in sail so ends this day.

Tues May 11th First part of this day wind South with rain at 10 A.M. hauled to N.W. & cleared up. kept off & run South until sunset then hauled to the wind heading N.W. & raised whale close to ship just at dark. Lat 38-15 Lon 71-15 slowed down the Oil so ends this day.

Wed May 12th First part of this day strong breeze from N.E. & clear & rough. latter part more fine under short sail. all day saw 3rd Carlton Bell a Whale Lat 38-09 Lon 71-23. at sunset quite moderate so ends this day.

Thurs May 13th This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather. At 5-30 A.M. raised whale going up a cross our bow couldn't get up to them. so kept off. at noon grove spits & stood N.E. saw whale ignored at 5 P.M. but couldn't get up so came on board Carlton Bell in sight Lat 37-47 Lon 71-26. so ends this day.

Friday May 14th First part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. & smoky weather. saw nothing saw Carlton Bell boiling. Lat 38-20 Lon 71-25 so ends this day.

Sat May 15th First part of this day fresh breeze from West & smoky. latter part more fine. At 4 P.M. raised whale towed and Starboard Boat fastened whale gammon & all boats fastened. Waist Boat got 2. Starboard Boat got 1. got alongside & made fast at 11-30 P.M. slop one whale from alongside Lat 38-17 Lon 71-07 so ends this day.

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Sunday May 16th First part of this day gentle breeze from N.E. & fine weather. latter part strong breeze. At daylight put up gear & hooked on to whale. all in at 11 A.M. started fire at 1 P.M. cut up heads. repaired Starboard Boat saw a Steamer bound East. Lat 38-27 Lon 70-36. so ends this day.

Mon May 17th This day gentle breeze from West & light fog. first part latter part wind N.W. & fair. boiling in company with Carlton Bell at 5 P.M. saw Carlton Bell with Boat down whale came close to us going quick toward & tried to head. run off large whale couldn't so came on board. Carlton Bell could do anything with him. got no Observation. so ends this day.

Tues May 18th First part of this day light air from N.E. & fine weather. middle part rain latter part clear & more breeze. finished boiling at 1-30 P.M. slowed down the oil Carlton Bell in sight Lat 38-25 Lon 70-57 so ends this day.

Wed May 19th This day first part fresh breeze from N.E. & clear. latter part more moderate. at 5-30 A.M. kept off & run to S.W. saw some spouts couldn't make them out whale. saw Bark Bertha cutting didn't get down to her before dark. Lat 37-45 Lon 72-17 so ends this day.

Thurs May 20th All this day fresh breeze from N.E. & clear. went on board Bark Bertha four whales in sight two boiling saw two steamers. Four masted schooner opened each Flour Lat 37-51 Lon 72-50 so ends this day.
