June 1st Tues. This day comes in with strong breeze from N.N.E. & fine weather latter part light from S.E. started the fire at 3 A.M. Boiling all day pumped some cask, & stowed down some Oil. saw nothing Lat 38-28 Lon 70-10

2nd Wed This day comes in with light breeze from South & fine weather middle & latter part fresh & rough. at 7 A.M. set Main sail & Staff. Top sail at 11 A.M. took it in again boiling & stowed some oil. exchanged soon with the English Steamer Sokota at 7 A.M. Lat 38-28 Lon 71-14

3rd This day comes in with light breeze from S.W. & fog. latter part light rain finished boiling at 4 P.M. stowed down some Oil. saw a Steamer bound S.E. saw nothing else. Lat 38-31 Lon 71-07

4th Friday First part of this day light breeze from S.E. & fair middle & latter part heavy rain stowed down the Oil & washed deck got no Observation. run to S.W. first then west saw nothing

5th This day gentle breeze from West & fog all day. under short sail most of the day. saw some spouts but didn't make them out called them whales. Lat 38-31 Lon 71-57 At 4 P.M. more ship & stood the North

6th This day first part fresh breeze from North & cloudy latter part N.W. & rough run to S.W. until 10 A.M. then hauled to the wind saw one whaler. saw lots of Porpoises got a sunset sight & made the Lon 72-13.

June 7th Monday. First part of this day strong breeze from N.N.E. & clear. latter part more moderate & fine raised some spouts but they were Transpud. At 2 P.M. set Main sail & hauled to Eastward saw two Schooners & Bark. saw two Steamers Lat 37-40 Lon 72-30. at sunset took in sail

8th Tues. First part of this day gentle breeze from East & fine middle part cloudy. latter part rain. At day light made all sail & stood to South raised some vessel to leeward chasing whales. At 11 A.M. tacked to North. At 5 P.M. went on board. Ellen A. Swift. saw two Steamers Swift reported Bark. Bertha taking two whales. got no Observation.

9th Wed. First part of this day gentle breeze from S.E. with heavy rain latter part S.W. & clear in company with Ellen Swift & J. Spenser saw a Steamer bound N.N.E. saw nothing. Lat 38 Lon 73-27. At 3-30 P.M. more white & stood to S.E. & took in sail

10th Thurs. first part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. with light rain. latter part clear & fair Swift & Turner in sight in the morning also a fire masted schooner bound South light at 7 A.M. set Fore sail & gibe & kept off & run East saw nothing Lat 37-55 Lon 72-16 at sunset took in sail & brought to

11th Friday First part of this day light airs from all around the compass with rain at 3 P.M. wind struck from N.E. & cleared up with gentle breeze saw lots of Porpoises saw some bitten squid Lat about 38-00 Lon 72-04
