

Journal Continued

- June 12<sup>th</sup> Sat. This day light breeze from E. N. E. & fine weather all day. Ellen Swift, Bertha Nickerson & J. Tomner in sight, also saw a hie masted & three masted scho. & two steamers. Lots of Porpoise & plenty of bitten squid. Lat 38-03 Lon 71-20. At sunset took in sail.
- 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday. First & middle part of this day light breeze from E. N. E. & fine weather latter part wind South at daylight made all sail & stood North until 8 A.M. then run to N. E. W. three whales in sight at daylight but J. Tomner left to try to go to the Eastward. Lat 38-13 Lon 71-30. Saw Grampus & Porpoise at sunset took in sail.
- 14<sup>th</sup> Monday. This day strong breeze from S. W. & smoke seen Ellen Swift, Bertha Nickerson & Bark Bertha at 2 P.M. under short sail latter part equally. Lat 38-03 Lon 72-04.
- 15<sup>th</sup> Tue. This day first & middle part gentle breeze from S. W. & fine latter part West & foggy. Spoke Bark Bertha, saw Nickerson & Swift. Saw some Grampus, Breuche, saw three coasters. Lat 38-15 Lon 72-12 at 3 P.M. took in light sails. At 5 P.M. took in sail.
- 16<sup>th</sup> Wed. All this day light air from East & hazy weather. At daylight made all sail & run S. W. Swift & Nickerson in sight running with me. saw lots Porpoise. Lat 38-09 Lon 72-30 carried sail all night.
- 17<sup>th</sup> Thurs. First & middle part of this day gentle breeze from S. W. & fine weather latter part fresh in company with Swift. saw Black fish & Porpoise, saw several steamers & three coasters. Lat 37-41 Lon 72-30 shifted water from Fore hole. At sunset under short sail.

- June 18<sup>th</sup> Friday. First part of this day fresh breeze from West & rough latter part light air from North & fine weather run S. W. under short sail all day. saw the Swift running with us. Lat 37-34 Lon 73-05 at sunset furled Flying jib.
- 19<sup>th</sup> This day gentle breeze from N. W. & fine weather. At daylight made all sail & run S. W. At noon wore ship & run South & raised whale at 12-30 lowered & starboard boat fastened whale. jammed & all three boats got of a piece. Cut in one whale. Starboard boat got alongside at 11 P.M. set watch at 11 P.M. Lat 36-50 Lon 73-20.
- 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday. This day calm all day. At daylight hooked on to whale & commenced to cut all in at 7 A.M. started fire at 9 A.M. in company with Ellen Swift she got two whales. saw a Barkentine. Lat 36-55 Lon 73-00.
- 21<sup>st</sup> Monday. This day gentle breeze from S. W. & fine weather. At 2 A.M. whale around the vessel. At daylight raised them & lowered Bark Bertha was close by & saw our boat down. she got a whale & the whale started off front on board & chased with the ship. came up to us at 3-30 P.M. & lowered without success. finished boiling at 9 P.M. Lat 37-03 Lon 73-04.
- 22<sup>nd</sup> Tue. This day gentle breeze from S. W. & fine weather. At daylight raised whale. lowered & starboard boat fastened killed whale. took him alongside & cut him all in at 9 A.M. started fire at 11 A.M. stowed down some oil. spoke steamer Oriole of New York at 3-30 P.M. raised whale again. lowered & starboard boat fastened & got store the other boats took line & killed whale. got a long side at 6 P.M. made all fast & took in sail. Spoke Bark Bertha Capt came on board. Lat 37-12 Lon 73-24.
