

Journal Continued

June 23rd Wed. First part of this day strong breeze from S.W. & rough. Latter part more moderate & fine weather. At day light put up gear & started to cut all in at 8 A.M. cut up the head & wore ship to get out of stream. saw two large boats. Lat 37-40 Lon 72-40.

" 24th Thurs. This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. At day light set mainsail & stood to South finished boiling at 8 A.M. set fore sail. saw Bark Bertha, also saw a Bark. Merchantsmen running W. to eastward. Lat 37-28 Lon 73-00 saw some. Tuck & lots of bitton squid stored down Oil.

" 25th Friday This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. At 8 A.M. made all sail & stood to Southward saw lots of Porpoises & Grampuses. saw four steamers went & spoke steamers, Prince, Castilian & tried to put letters on board. but she would not stop for us. finished stowing Oil & washed ship at sunset took in hail Lat 37-52 Lon 73-15

" 26th Sat. This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. At 8 A.M. raised whales, lowered & starboard boat fastened got alongside at 11 A.M. put up gear & cut whale all in at 12-30 At 3 P.M. raised whale again to forward & starboard boat fastened got alongside at sunset made all fast wore ship & took in sail Lat 36-55 Lon 73-00 set watch at 8 P.M. cut up the head.

" 27th Sunday. First & middle part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather latter part more moderate. At day light set mainsail & hooked on to whale all in at 6-30 A.M. made sail & cruised, started fire at 9 A.M. saw lots of Spym Grampuses, saw three Steamers Lat 36-59 Lon 73-50 At 6-30 P.M. took in sail

so ends this day.

June 28th Monday This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. At 6 A.M. raised whales, lowered two boats & starboard boat fastened got alongside at noon. cut whale all in at 3 P.M. Shift Coakley of Schⁿ Marguerite of New York came on board. saw several steamers bound North Lat 36-55 Lon 73-50. set watch at 8 P.M.

" 29th Tues. This day strong breeze from S.W. & rough latter part equally with thunder & lightning. finished boiling at 6-30 P.M. plowed down some Oil Swift Bark Bertha & Jackson in sight. Nickerson & Swift both boiling. also tried to head off a steamer. Lat 36-51 Lon 73-15

" 30th Wed. This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather saw the whole fleet of whales. put letters on board Four masted Schⁿ Eagle King of Jamaica bound to Boston. saw Grampuses & Porpoises finished stowing Oil & washed ship Lat 36-48 Lon 73-15

July 1st Thurs. First & middle part of this day light breeze from S.W. & fine weather latter part strong breeze. At 8-30 A.M. raised whales, lowered all three boats without success. came on board at noon & spoke to port masted. saw Ellen Swift later a whale spoke steamer, Olinda of New York & got some papers. Lat 37-05 Lon 73-15

" 2nd Friday First part of this day wind West & quite rough. latter part fine & pretty moderate. saw lots of bitton squid green fresh. saw Porpoises. Bark Bertha in sight. Lat 36-37. Lon 73-15

" 3rd Sat. First part of this day strong breeze from S.W. latter took a Squall from N.W. with rain. At 8-30 A.M. raised whale a head going quick to S.W. got whale ready. but did not lower whale in the stream at 10 A.M. shortened sail & gave whale up. saw a steamer & Four masted Schⁿ Lat 36-47 Lon 73-16
