July 26th Monday This day comes in with calm at 9 A.M. it
 breezed up gently breeze from S.E. & very fine weather
 At 10 A.M. raised whale, lowered & Starboard boat
 fastened whale, gammed, & all three boats fastened
 Main Boat got two, got a longside at 1 P.M. put up
 gear & started to cut ball in at 6.30 P.M. sent down
 gear & took on sail, started to cut up heads
 set watch at 8 P.M. Lat-37-25 Lon 72-52
 stowed down Oil so ends this day.

July 27th Tues. This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
 boiling At 8 A.M. raised whale, going quick to
 S.E. lowered without success, came on board at noon
 started to pump cask, at 3-30 P.M. raised whale
 bruching, lowered & Starboard boat fastened
 whale, flopped & all three boats got a whale
 got a longside & made all fast at sunset
 took in sail & set watch Lat-37-20 Lon 73-15
 so ends this day.

July 28th Wed. This day calm all day & very hot At daylight
 hooked on to whale, & stowed down some Oil At 10 A.M.
 whale came close to ship got two boats ready
 & lowered Starboard boat fastened whale, gammed
 & Starboard fastened got two enough to fill, every
 thing would bother with any more got a long side
 cleared a way the heads, & cut the other whale
 all in at sunset saw 5 Steamers set watch
 at 8 P.M.

July 29th Thurs. This day comes in with light air from
 S.W. & fine weather boiling & spring cooked from
 basket & filled all the Blue Oil, running N.W.
 At 1 P.M. set the Main sail & Foresail Lat-37-40
 started for home so ends this day.

July 30th Friday This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather
 boiling At 10 A.M. with all set but the Foresail boiling
 finished boiling at 12 P.M. saw two four Madaket
 stowed down home oil Lat-37-33 Lon 72-20
 so ends this day.

July 31st Sat. This day comes in with light breeze from
 North At 8 A.M. tacked ship & stood in shore
 At 11 A.M. sighted Montauk Pt. wind gradually
 hauled to N.E. At sunset a breeze from Block Id.
 stowed down Oil & washed ship bent the chains
 & painted Mast heads, & got ready to go in to the
 Hook,

Aug 1st Sunday This day light air from N.E. & fine weather
 At daylight about 10 miles E.N.E. from Block Island
 worked up to Gullyhunk & took Pilot on board, at 5 P.M.
 Anchored at 8-30 P.M. so ends this day & Voyage of
 2 months & 25 days.
