- May 10 Tues. This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. moderate in the afternoon. Saw 3 schools of whales. Lower two boats twice never got any. Sun set clear so end this day. Lat 38.11. Long 71.05.
- 11 Wed. This day comes in cloudy with a light breeze from the W. at 8 A.M. increased to fresh. took off the Starboard anchor stock. Cloudy at sunset so end this day. Lat 38.31. Long 71.09.
- 12 Thurs. This day comes in with rain and a light breeze from the S.W. set sail steering to the Westward at 11.30 A.M. took in the mainsail. at 2 P.M. wind shifted to the N. fresh. hauled down the foresail Coast W.S.W. no observation at noon. cloudy at sunset. By D.R. Lat 38.25. Long 71.57.
- 13 Fri. This day comes in clear with a light breeze from the N. set sail cruising steering westward. at 6 P.M. took in sails clear at sunset so end this day. Lat 38.00 Long 72.32.
- 14 Sat. This day dawn clear with a light breeze from the N. set sail. Saw a school of whales lower 3 boats never got any. At 6.30 P.M. took in sail. Sun set clear. so end this day. Lat 37.44. Long 72.47.
- 15 Sun. This day comes in clear Wind N.E. light. set sail and stood to the Eastward. then steered South. one bark in sight. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got 2 whales Starboard boat one Starboard boat one came alongside made the whales fast. took in sail. Sun set clear so end this day. Lat 37.47. Long 72.19.
- 16 Mon. This day comes in clear. Wind N.E. light. cut up both whales and commence to boil. Cruising under mainsail and jibs at 6.30 P.M. set the foretrialsail took in the mainsail. Sun set clear. so end this day. Lat 37.39. Long 72.44.
- 17 Tues. Morning clear Wind E. light. finish boiling at 1 A.M. wash the deck & set sail. Saw a school of whales lower 3 boats Starboard boat got one. came alongside cut him up. commence to boil. took in sail set the trysails Sun set clear so end this day. Lat 37.45. Long 72.56.

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- May 18 Wed. Morning cloudy Wind S.S.E. light. At 9 A.M. rain with moderate breeze finish boiling at 10 A.M. stored the oil. Sun set clear so end this day. Lat 38.03. Long 72.23.
- 19 Thurs. This day comes in clear wind N.W. light. set sail. raised a school of whales they passed by. At 1.30 P.M. carried away the martingale. made & new one and put it on. At 6 P.M. took in sail. Sun set clear so end this day. Lat 38.05. Long 72.06.
- 20 Fri. Morning clear Wind W. light. set up the head gear. set all sails cruising. 2 Steamers in sight. put up the jack rings. Saw some sports. at 6.30 P.M. took in sail. Sun set cloudy so end this day. Lat 38.03. Long 72.06.
- 21 Sat. This day comes in cloudy Wind S.W. fresh. have too. Saw a school of Blackfish. Cloudy at sunset so ends this day. Cook: Clarence Hyatt and Seaman Dennis Harris off duty sick. Lat 38.14. Long 72.13.
- 22 Sun. This day comes in foggy. Wind N.E. light. set the foresail. At 6 P.M. took in sail Sun set clear so ends this day. C. Hyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 38.11. Long 72.07.
- 23 Mon. Morning clear Wind N.E. light. made sail and stood S. raised a school of whales. lowered 2 boats whales passed by. At 7 P.M. took in sail. Sun set cloudy so ends this day. C. Hyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 37.49. Long 72.50.
- 24 Tues. Morning cloudy wind South West. moderate. spoke the Steamer Aspromonte. At 7 P.M. have too. Sun set cloudy. so ends this day. C. Hyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 38.10. Long 72.02.
