

Journal Continued

May 25. Wed. This day comes in cloudy. Wind S. W. moderate. At 11. A. M. breeze increased to fresh. At 2.30. P. M. commence to rain. At 5.30. P. M. hoist the flying jib off the boom; reef the maintrissail hoist the boats on upper crane. C. Wyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. The observation: L. R. Lat 38.10. Long 72.25. So ends this day.

26 Thurs: This day comes in foggy Wind W. light. At 9 A. M. fog cleared. hoist the foresail. 2 vessels in sight. raised a school of Blackfish lowered 3 boats. Starboard boat got 2. Waist boat one. Waist boat 2. Came alongside cut them up. Sun set clear. C. Wyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 38.30. Long 72.50. So ends this day.

27 Fri: This day comes in clear. Wind W. moderate. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got 2. Came alongside cut them in. took in the mainsail. At 7. P. M. commence to boil. Sun set clear. C. Wyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 38.11. Long 72.34. So ends this day.

28 Sat. Morning clear Wind N. W. moderate. 1 vessel and 2 Steamers in sight. spoke the Steamer Moracas. finish boiling at 8. P. M. Sun set clear. C. Wyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 37.32 Long 72.28. So ends this day.

29 Sun. Morning clear Wind N. N. W. moderate. boarded the Steamer Simon. Stowed the oil. At 6. P. M. calm took in sail Sun set clear. C. Wyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 37.36. Long 72.24. So ends this day.

30 Mon. Morning cloudy Wind S. W. light. At 8. A. M. light rain. At 10.30. A. M. Wind shifted West clear. At 1. P. M. set sail wash the ship. At 4. P. M. took in sail Sun set clear. C. Wyatt & D. Harris off duty sick. Lat 38.00. Long 72.30. So ends this day.

31 Tues. This day comes in clear Wind W. light. made sail raised a school of whales lowered 2 boats Starboard boat got one. came alongside cut him up. At 3 P. M. commence to boil. At 6 P. M. took in sail Sun set clear Wind North Clarence Wyatt and Dennis Harris on duty. Boatsteerer Victor Slocum off duty sick. Lat 37.52. Long 72.00. So ends this day.

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June 1st Wed: This day comes in clear Wind W. light. set sail at 8.30. A. M. finish boiling at 11. A. M. fresh breeze took in the mainsail stowed the oil Sun set clear. Victor Slocum off duty sick. Lat 38.08. Long 72.08. So ends this day.

2 Thurs: Morning cloudy Wind N. S. W. light. made sail. At 11. A. M. clear with a fresh breeze. took in the mainsail at 1. P. M. Calm then light breeze. set the mainsail boarded the Sch. Marian Cobb. of New York. from Boston for Brunswick. Ga. and sent home letters. Victor Slocum on duty. at 7.30 P. M. took in sail Sun set clear. Lat 37.08. Long 72.27. So ends this day.

3. Fri: This day comes in cloudy wind S. S. W. moderate hoist the foresail at 10.30. A. M. fresh breeze haul down the foresail boats on upper cranes Wind shifted west. Sun set clear with same fresh breeze J. P. Lat. 38.10. Long 73.01. So ends this day.

4. Sat: This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. N. E. moderate in the afternoon. 1 Bark and one steamer in sight. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats: Starboard boat got one. Starboard boat got his boom broke. came alongside and made fast. Sun set clear. Lat 37.55. Long 73.03. So ends this day.

5. Sun: This day comes in with a light breeze from the S. W. cut in the whale and at 5. A. M. commenced to boil. At 1. P. M. wind increased to fresh with rain. finish boiling at 4. P. M. Sun set cloudy. Lat 37.30. Long 73.15. So ends this day.

6. Mon: This day comes in cloudy wind S. N. fresh with rain. stop raining. Stowed down the oil and wash the deck. Sun set clear. Lat 37.50. Long 72.26. So ends this day.

7. Tues: This day comes in foggy wind N. N. W. light. At 10. A. M. clear set sail. 1 Str and 1 Sch. in sight. At 7. P. M. took in sail. Sun set clear. Lat 37.51. Long 72.30. So ends this day.

8. Wed: This day comes in clear Wind N. W. light. set sail and stood to the S. W. moved the anchor chains from forward aft. at 7.30. P. M. took in sail Sun set cloudy. Lat 37.03. Long 72.50. So ends this day.
