June 25 Sat: This day comes in clear. Wind N.E. fresh. E. of Swift and Margaret in sight raised whale other 2 Schrs got: we note Starboard boat broke its rudder. At 5 P.M. finish boiling sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 36.41. Long 73.53.
Victor Stocum off duty sick.

26. Sun: This day comes in clear with a light breeze from the N.E. set sail wind increased to fresh. Took in sail Schrs E. of Swift and Margaret in sight. stored the oil. saw some grampases. Sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 36.45. Long 73.46.
Victor Stocum off duty sick.

27. Mon: This day comes in calm. Schrs Margaret and Swift in sight. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got 3 whales came alongside and commence to cut. raised another school of whales laved the waistboat. got one whale came alongside and made fast for the night. At 11 A.M. light breeze. Sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 36.50 Long 73.50.
T. Stocum on duty.

28. Tues: This day comes in cloudy. Wind S.W. fresh. cut in the whale we had alongside and commence to boil moderate in the afternoon. Sun set cloudy so ends this day. Lat 36.57. Long 73.49.

29. Wed: This day comes in clear wind W. light. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got one whale. Starboard boat came alongside and cut him in still boiling sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 36.54 Long 73.29.

30. Thurs: This day comes in clear wind W. light. set the mainsail. still boiling. Schrs Margaret in sight. At 6.30 P.M. took in sail sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 37.00. Long 73.56.

July 1 Fri: This day comes in clear wind S.W. light. finish boiling at 5 A.M. made sail. stored some of the oil. Schrs E. of Swift and Margaret in sight raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got one whale. Starboard boat came alongside and cut him in toft in the mainsail. Sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 36.50. Long 73.58.

July 2. Sat: This day comes in clear wind W. Light. set the mainsail. commence to boil at 1 A.M. finish boiling 1 P.M. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got 3 whales Starboard boat 2 Starboard boat 1. Came alongside and made them fast for the night took in sail sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 37.04. Long 73.26.
Victor Stocum off duty sick.

3. Sun: This day comes in clear wind S.W. light cut in the 3 whales and at 11 A.M. commence to boil. At 7 P.M. took in sail sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 37.38. Long 73.30.
Victor Stocum and Obrian off duty sick.

4. Mon: This day comes in clear wind S.W. fresh. boiling and cruising under trisails. finish boiling at 11.30 P.M. Sun set cloudy so ends this day. Lat 37.20. Long 73.34.
T. Stocum off duty sick. Obrian on duty.

5. Tues: This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the E. followed by rain staved the oil. moderate in the afternoon. Sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 37.12. Long 74.13.
T. Stocum off duty sick.

6. Wed: Morning clear wind N.E. light. raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got 2 whales came alongside and cut them in: took in sail so ends this day. Lat 36.43. Long 74.11.
Victor Stocum and George Willard off duty sick.

7. Thurs: This day comes in clear wind S.W. light. boiling: raised a school of whales lower 2 boats got 1 whale. Starboard boat came alongside and cut him in. Sun set cloudy with a fresh breeze. so ends this day. Lat 36.47. Long 73.44.
T. Stocum G. Willard and off duty sick.

8. Fri: This day comes in cloudy with a fresh breeze and rain from the S.W. still boiling. At 2 P.M. clear stop raining. Sun set clear so ends this day. Lat 37.00. Long 73.34.
