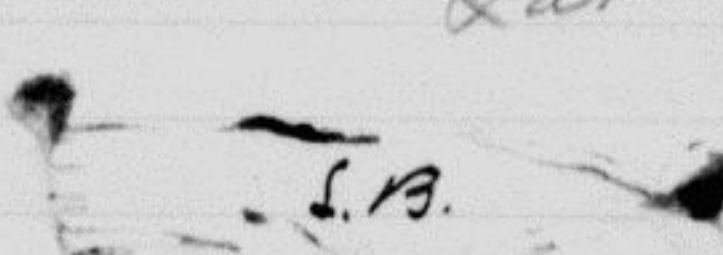


Journal Continued

- May 15 Monday This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the N.E. At 8 a.m. saw the Swift and Bell cutting in whales went on board of the Swift stowed to the S.E. and raised breeches but it came in thick fog and remained so all day but some net-fishing on the deck and took in sail so ended this day. Calm.
- " 16 Tuesday This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. made sail in company with the C. Bell and Swift. 8 a.m. raised whales and lowered. The Bell struck one and the rest went to windward took boats up whales were off lowered again and struck one boat came alongside and cut him in Swift and Margaret in night started the work going so ended this day.

- " 17 Wednesday This day comes in with light breeze from S.W. stowed to the Litterware at noon jibed over to the N.E. in company with the C. Bell came in thick fog saw a lot of finbacks.

- " 18 Thurs. This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. made sail in company with the Bell and worked to the North saw the A.M. Nicholson with foresail in use on board of him also Capt. Seneca of the Bell came on board.

- " 19 Friday This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. made sail in company with the A.M. Nicholson and C. Bell at 4 P.M. flat calm at 7 P.M. Capt. Gonsalves of the T. Turner came on board.

- " 20 Saturday This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. made sail in company with T. Turner and A.M. Nicholson at noon died out calm hence the Nicholson and Turner

- May 21 Sunday This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. At 4 P.M. went on board of the C. Bell at 5.30 came in thick fog and continued so all night -

- " 22 Monday This day comes in calm and continues so all day, but killed by an English Str. 5 whales in sight.
 37-04 71-22
- " 23 Tuesday This day comes in with a light breeze from the West. Haver a school of whales lowered down and the Mini went in and struck a whale brought him alongside and commenced to cut then raised more whales lowered one boat and the Mini struck again came alongside and cut them both in and started the work going

- " 24 Wednesday This day begins with calm at 4.30 raised whales lowered the S. Boat - L. Boat got 3 whales and killed another and the Margaret picked it up came alongside and cut them in Swift in sight remained calm all day.

- " 25 Thursday This day comes in thick and wind is the S.W. crew busy on sail on 4 masts in sight killed part the same
