- May 26 Friday This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. crew all busy in oil boiling and stowing down Lathi part the same Lat-37-36 Long 74-19
- 27 Saturday This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. finished boiling and stowed down some oil Lathi part the same Lat-37-47 Long 72-02
- 28 Sunday This day comes in with fog and moderate freshened stowing the oil and washed the ship cleared off in the afternoon with N.E. Lat-37-00 Long 73-00
- 29 Monday This day comes in with light breeze from the N.E. and fine weather wind hailed in the P.M. in the afternoon Lat-37-34 Long 73-11
- 30 Tuesday This day comes in calm 4 whales in sight all day Lat-37-11
- 31 Wednesday This day comes in calm 4 whales in sight all day Breeze up from the East in the afternoon light Lat-36-55 Long 73-27
- June 1 Thurs. This day comes in with a light breeze Capt. Generals of the P. Turner came on board at 1 p.m. at 4.30 went on board of the A.M. Nicholson Capt. Maudslayi of the Margaret was there B.D. W. Skene in sight boiling Lat-37-00 Long 72-40

- June 2 Friday This day comes in with a light breeze N.E. Margaret left for the Eastward at 3 p.m. Capt. Lathi came on board and then went on board of the A.M. Nicholson Lat-37-06 Long 72-11
- 3 Saturday This day comes in with a light breeze from the Westward Turner, B.D. W. Skene and A.M. Nicholson in sight Lathi part the same Lat-37-14 Long 72-18
- 4 Sunday This day comes in hazy and light breeze S.E. saw the B.D. W. Skene Lat-36-50
- 5 Mon. This day comes in light from S.E. and rain P.M. W. Skene in sight wind changed to West Lat-37-36 Long 72-36
- 6 Tuesday This day comes in with light breeze from the Southward at 10 a.m. saw the B.D. W. Skene with 2 boats fast at 4 p.m. made a tack to the Westward and a small whale saw and the small boat struck came along side and made fast in the night Lat-37-09 Long 73-36
- 7 Wednesday This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the North at 4 a.m. hooked on to the whale and cut him in and started the fish going Lat-37-03 Long 73-56
- 8 Thursday This day comes in with a fresh breeze from N.E. P. Turner in sight Lathi part the same vessel under short sail Lat-36-36 Long 74-00
- 9 Friday This day comes in with a fresh breeze from the North P. Turner in sight at 3 p.m. raised the B.D. W. Skene shortened sail heading to the Westward moderating quite a little Lat-36-30 Long 74-17
