June 10th Saturday this day comes in calm raised whales lower 3 boats and made with the B. E. Wickersham the Wickersham struck 2 whales and brought one alongside of us commenced to cut finished cutting and set the works going Capt. Lantis came on board & saw more whales at 8 p.m.

11th Sunday this day comes in with a very light breeze from the S. W. finished hoisting and Capt. Lantis came on board and got 1 case of oil latter part very light breeze

12th Monday this day comes in with a fresh breeze from the South remained as all day B. E. Wickersham in sight

13th Tuesday this day comes in with the wind from the Southward made sail and steered to the Eastward and S. E. in company with the B. E. Wickersham all day

14 Wednesday this day comes in with a fair breeze from the West in the Wickersham looking whales alongside at 5 p.m. raised whales lowered and got one came alongside and made fast for the night

15 Thursday this day comes in with light breeze from the Westward looked on the whale at daylight finished cutting and raised more whales lowered and got 4 brought them alongside and cut them in and set the works going

16 Friday this day comes in with a fair breeze from the S. W. crew busy boring oil at 3 p.m. raised whales going quick to windward gave chase but did not get near them

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June 17 Sat. this day comes in with a fair breeze from the Westward B. E. Wickersham in sight
Lat. 37-32 Long 72-07

18 Sunday this day comes in light breeze and fog from the S. W. remained as most of the day
37-18 Long 72-35

19 Mon. this day comes in light breeze from the S. W. saw the G. W. Hickman cutting in went on board of her she had 3 whales caught day before at 10 a.m. raised 2 lower whales lowered for them whales went out of sight and a net came
37-22 73-09

20 Tues. this day comes in calm saw the Wickersham's boats and lowered and got 2 whales brought them alongside and cut them in started the sails going
37-24 73-00

21 Wednesday this day comes in nearly calm saw Wickersham Boat lowered and got 1 whale larger alongside with him and cut him in
37-13 Long 73-26

22 Thurs. this day comes in with a fair breeze from the West and then hauled to the S. W.
Lat. 36-55 Long 73-17

23 Fri. this day comes in wind in the Westward B. E. Wickersham and Swift in sight - saw the Wickersham
Lat. 37-23 Long 72-49

24 Sat. this day comes in with a light breeze from the Eastward 3 whales in sight all steering S. W.
Lat. 37-21 Long 72-51

25 Sunday this day comes in with a light breeze from the S. W. at 4 p.m. went on board of the Swift and then it came in thick fog
