Tuesday, Feb. 1. 1857. Lat. 03.08. Long. 100.58

P.M. Employed painting & scraping. Sunset steering N.W. Middle and latter part light winds. Employed scraping ironwork & painting.

Wednesday, Feb. 2. 1857. Lat. 04.53. Long. 103.12

P.M. Sent down cutting penants and cleaned them. Sunset steering W.N.W. These two were still off duty. The Carpenter below sick to day with the scurvy. Latter part employed breaking out and sand & opening bread.

Thursday, Feb. 3. 1857. Lat. 04.35. Long. 106.20

P.M. Breaking out. Sunset steering W.N. all sail set. Middle and latter part moderate winds. Employed iron work & painting.

Friday, Feb. 4. 1857. Lat. 04.46. No Long

P.M. Employed the same. Sunset steering W.N. all sail set. Middle and latter part rain squalls. Not cutting penants off.

Saturday, Feb. 5. 1857. Lat. 04.55. No Long.

P.M. Employed on iron work & painting. Sunset steering West. Latter part at daylight lowered for 8 ft. Water. Not two L.B. BB.

Sunday, Feb. 6. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Shaving. Sunset set the watches will cut to morning. Commenced to cut at daylight got on in at noon.

Monday, Feb. 7. 1857. Lat. 06.15. Long. 111.58

P.M. Employed cutting got through at four. Middle and latter part clearing decks.

Wednesday, Feb. 9. 1857. Lat. 04.04. Long. 116.46

P.M. Baling. Sunset steering W.N. all sail set. Middle and latter part moderate winds. Got through baling at noon.

Thursday, Feb. 10. 1857. Lat. 03.45. Long. 118.09

P.M. Getting oil ready to stow down. Sunset steering W.N. Latter part employed coopers oil.

Friday, Feb. 11. 1857. Lat. 03.00. Long. 120.28

P.M. Frequent rain squalls. Sunset steering W.N. Latter part stowed down (2796) gallons of oil between decks.

Saturday, Feb. 12. 1857. Lat. 01.20. Long. 121.39

P.M. Employed washing ship inside. Sunset steering W.N. Latter part employed washing ship.

Sunday, Feb. 13. 1857. Lat. 00.41. S. No Long.

P.M. Sunset lowered for a school of small whales got none. dark. Kept off West. All latter part moderate weather and hazy.

Monday, Feb. 14. 1857. Lat. 00.14. S. Long. 124.17

P.M. Sunset steering N.W. Middle and latter part light winds. Have been employed scraping iron work & painting.
