

Remarks made on board. Bark Wm Baylies.

Wednesday Apr. 27. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Tried to wear and could not. Wind N.W. and quite cold. A number of sails in sight. Middle and latter part light N.E. winds with snow. Laying in the ice.

Thursday. Apr. 28. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Made sail standing through ice making to the North & East wind N.W. One sail in sight. Middle and latter part strong North winds with snow.

Friday. Apr. 29. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Hauling Bark Wanderer & A. Barker weather better. Middle and latter part light N.W. winds. Capt. went on board Bark Sea Breeze a little while.

Saturday. Apr. 30. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Working to the North & East through ice. No Whale yet. Middle and latter part light North winds. Employed in Ship's duty.

Sunday. May 1. 1857. Lat. 60. 55. Long. 173. 46. 6

P.M. Working to the Northward through ice. Five P.M. Spoke Bark Sea Breeze Capt. went on board. Latter part kept off to the Southward bound round to the Eastward. A. Barker & Reinier also kept off.

Monday. May 2. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Running through ice wind E.N.E. and snowing. Lost sight of them Ships at sunset. Midnight came to on the port tack. Kept off again at daylight working East.

Tuesday. May 3. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Strong winds from E.N.E. and plenty of scattering ice. Employed breaking out water. Sunset. Two sails in sight steering same way. Latter part hauling Bark A. Barker Reinier and Mary & Susan. Capt. came on board at sun and kept off East.

Wednesday. May 4. 1857. Lat. 58. 26. Long. 178. 40

P.M. Light west wind came up to the ice again at ten midnight. To came to the wind. Hauling at dusk. Latter part kept off East Light West wind. Hauling A. Barker & Reinier.

Thursday. May 5. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Sunset. Capt. came on board. Kept off again E.N.E. morning. Midnight came up to the ice again came to the wind. Kept off again at daylight East in company with Bark Reinier & A. Barker.

Friday. May 6. 1857. Lat. 57. 32. Long. 184. 14. 27

P.M. Steering the same. Sunset no change. Sent the Fore Royal down for repairs. Latter part hauling Bark Reinier & A. Barker.

Saturday. May 7. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Steering E.S. following along the ice. Latter part steering N.E.

Sunday. May 8. 1857. No Observation

P.M. Made the ice again bearing P.M. So hauled up by the wind. A. Barker & Reinier in sight. Latter part sa. calm.
