

Remarks made on board Bark *Wm Baylee*

Friday, May 20, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Weather thick from the Eastward. Same as at dark yesterday. Middle and latter part light winds from the Northward and thick.

Saturday, May 21, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Ran down and up the Bark *Helen Mary* Capt. spent on board. Sunset gaming. Middle and latter part steering North through scattering ice. Made fast to the shore and got fresh water.

Sunday, May 22, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Weather thick and foggy. Saw *Helen Mary* & *Mary & Susan* in sight. Middle and latter part weather foggy.

Monday, May 23, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Gaming. Barks *Helen Mary* & *Mary & Susan*. Sunset weather the same. Latter part it lit up. Made sail working to the Northward & Westward.

Tuesday, May 24, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Sunset a calm with plenty of ice. Ships leaving at dark. *Helen Mary* & *Mary & Susan* in sight. Middle and latter part weather thick.

Wednesday, May 25, 1857. Drove in the ice.

P.M. Clear weather but light winds. Have been working North hauling ice. Sunset no wind. *H. Mary* & *M. Susan* in sight. Middle and latter part thick foggy weather. Wind North.

Wednesday, May 26, 1857. Lat. 60.40. Long. 165.01. East

P.M. Are now fast in the ice which *Mary & Susan* & *Helen Mary* drove to. Wind and weather the same. Latter part under steam worked out the shore water. *Mary & Susan* & *Helen Mary* froze in.

Thursday, May 27, 1857. Lat. 61.32. Long. 169.09

P.M. Working North in clear water. Sunset wind North. Ice weather. Made sail at daylight working North.

Friday, May 28, 1857. Lat. 61.41. No Long.

P.M. Light North winds and clear with scattering ice. Lost sight of the *Mary & Susan* & *Helen Mary*. Middle and latter part light North winds. Still working North through ice.

Saturday, May 29, 1857. Lat. 61.41. No Long.

P.M. Wind the same. Sunset *Mary & Susan* in sight. Latter part light North winds. Sunset the Western ice heavy so working to the Eastward in company with the *Mary & Susan*.

Sunday, May 30, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Still working East. Wind light. Gaming the *Mary & Susan*. Latter part wind S.E. Kept off N.W. in company with *Mary & Susan*. Plenty of ice.

Monday, May 31, 1857. No Observation

P.M. Rose land off Starboard beam. Sunset steering North. *Helen Mary* in sight. Latter part strong N.W. winds got in clear water and working to the Northward. Tack and tack.
