

Remarks made on board. Bark *Wm. Bowlin*

Sunday, July 10. 1857.

P.M. Got all the water on board will be ready for use at ten P.M. Latter part took our departure bound for Point Hope. Wind East and thick

Monday, July 11. 1857.

P.M. Got down to anchor at three off Point Hope. Wind working to the Northward. Fifteen ships lay by at anchor. Middle and latter part thick foggy weather

Tuesday, July 12. 1857.

P.M. Blowing strong from S.E. with heavy swell and thick weather. Latter part blowing strong and thick weather all the ships but three gone out.

Wednesday, July 13. 1857.

P.M. Got underway at two bound for the coal mines for coal, steering N.W. Past Cape Lisburne at nine then steered E.N.E. Gaattering ice around. Latter part past Cape Lisburne then steered E.N.E. came to anchor at noon.

Thursday, July 14. 1857

Sent three boats shore on coaling. Kept at work all night, watch and watch. Employed coaling with all hands. Bark *Thomas Pope* in sight.

Friday, July 15. 1857.

P.M. Employed coaling. At six *Quartermaster* down to the Bark *Thomas Pope* for anchorage. Latter part got through coaling and have been employed getting stores from Bark *Tom Pope*.

Saturday, July 16. 1857

P.M. Employed generally. Latter part moderate weather & clear. Hauled a little further off shore.

Sunday, July 17. 1857.

P.M. Employed at ship's duty. Middle part took our departure from the coal mines and light from the Eastward steering North.

Monday, July 18. 1857.

P.M. Calm. Lowered a boat to go ducking got none. Four sails in sight steering eastward. Midnight came up to the ice did not try to get through it. Weather thick raining.

Tuesday, July 19. 1857.

P.M. Raining. Three sails in sight all doing nothing. Wind S.E. and strong. Middle and latter part thick rainy weather stood into the ice then more of again.

Wednesday, July 20. 1857.

P.M. Wind moderated down to a calm. Fifteen ships in sight all doing nothing. Midnight wind worked to the N.W. and clear.

Thursday, July 21. 1857.

P.M. Working North until coming to the then more rounded. Sighting Bark *Reindeer* & *Jacob Holland*. Midnight anchored off Point Hope in seven fathoms of water. Wind N.E.
