Tuesday Sept. 14. 1847.

P.M. Employed boiling. Middle and latter part employed boiling. Wind light from S.E.

Thursday Sept. 15. 1847.

P.M. Lowered for whale going. P.M. Quirk did not get any. Six P.M. boiling. Latter part lowered again. Whales going. Quirk got nothing.

Friday Sept. 16. 1847.

P.M. Strong winds. Employed boiling and stowing down. Middle and latter part moderate winds. Got through boiling at ten.

Saturday Sept. 17. 1847.

P.M. Lowered again and got nothing. Whales very shy. J. Howland & Lancer lowered got nothing. Seven P.M. stowing down. Got through stowing down at twelve. P.M. Latter part nothing doing. Lancer & J. Howland chasing.

Sunday Sept. 18. 1847.

P.M. Employed at Ship's duty. Six P.M. gannet. The Lancer. All middle and latter part a thick snow storm. Lowered again at eight. got nothing. Whales going. Quirk. Lancer & Howland and Francis Palmer also lowered got nothing.

Monday Sept. 19. 1847.

P.M. Strong winds nothing out. But lower topsails are in sight astern. Latter part strong North winds. Lowered at daylight. chased and got nothing. J. Howland, Francis Palmer and Lancer got one each.

Tuesday Sept. 20. 1847. Lat. 72.20. North

P.M. Lowered again. L.B. struck at four got him alongside at six. Blowing strong. P.M. got through at seven. Blowing a strong breeze from the N.E.

Wednesday Sept. 21. 1847. Lat. 71.44. N. Long.

P.M. Made sail lower topsails working to Eastward nothing in sight. Latter part moderate winds. Lowered at ten chased and got nothing.

Thursday Sept. 22. 1847.

P.M. Lowered again. Bow Boat struck got him alongside at three and cut in at eight. P.M. Made sail standing to the Westward. J. Howland, Lancer, F. Palmer in sight. Boiling. Latter part lowered for a whale going. Quirk did not get him.

Friday Sept. 23. 1847.

P.M. Started to boil. Six P.M. gannet. Barks Lancer & Belvedere former a boiling. Latter part lowered again got nothing. A number of Phos in sight chasing.

Saturday Sept. 24. 1847.

P.M. Employed boiling and stowing down. Latter part a light breeze. Lowered with the Lancer whale going. Quirk. P.M. got nothing.

Sunday Sept. 25. 1847. Lat. 71.40. Long. 151.37

P.M. Employed boiling. Sunset calm. Middle and latter part calm. Employed boiling.
