Monday, Oct. 17. 1817. Port through 172. Passage

7. PM

P.M. Weather the same but squalls of snow. Sun set steering S.E. Nothing in sight. Latter part wind S.W. with heavy squalls. Steering S.E.

Tuesday, Oct. 18. 1817. Lat. 52.00 Long 165.10

P.M. Pass the land. Fort Belknap ahead. Port through the passage at four just four days from Planet Bay. are now steering E.S. Middle and latter part strong winds from S.W. Have been employed to day drying sails since cutting falls getting ready for port.

Wednesday, Oct. 19. 1817. Lat. 60.00 Long 144.20

P.M. Today bent a new Main topgallant sent down the Crowned. Weather squally but much light. Sun set steering E.S. nothing in sight. Latter part wind squally from S.E. Employed breaking out water

Thursday, Oct. 20. 1817. No Observation

P.M. Wind the same yet turbulent and strong. Sun set by the wind heading East. all sail set. Nothing in sight. Middle and latter part wind S.E. light ahead with light squalls of wind.

Friday, Oct. 21. 1817. No Observation

P.M. No change. Sun set standing to the Eastward all sail set. Nothing in sight. Latter part wind increasing. Parted everything but lower main top sail. Raining some wind E.W.

Grave Montrose. Western.

Sat Oct 22. 1817. No Observation

P.M. Wind blowing with great violence and raining hard. There moderate and working to the S.E. Some ship heading to the North. Midnight blowing very hard with heavy sea. Latter part moderating and clear. sail heading to the Eastward.

Sunday, Oct. 23. 1817. Lat. 50.40. Long 113.10

P.M. Employed generally. Sun set Wind S.E. with heavy sea. Ship heading to the Eastward under top sail & courses. Middle and latter part strong S.E. winds with heavy swell.

Monday, Oct. 24. 1817. Lat. 49.33. Long 100.50

P.M. No change strong S.E. winds with thick smoky weather. Sun set on the Eastward under top sail & courses. Middle and latter part wind gradually working to the Southward. Employed in between decks getting ready to stem down.

Tuesday, Oct. 25. 1817. Lat. 45.23 Long 147.26

P.M. Strong South wind. Sun set steering E.S. Middle part raining. Wind the same. Latter part light winds with fog.

Wednesday, Oct. 26. 1817. No Observation

P.M. Got a breeze again from the Southward at two it freshened S.W. and increasing. Sun set in Royal steering E.S. Middle and latter part rain and some wind working forward. set the royal again. Have been employed getting ready for port.
