Monday Nov 28. Lat Long
P.M. hands busy coiling whale line
sunset with the wind at N-N-East
steering S-S-West middle part pleasant
wind at North morning hands employed
mending sails.

Tuesday Nov 29 Lat 27-30 Long 135-19
P.M. employed repairing and bending
sails sunset with wind at N-N-East
steering S-S-East middle and latter part
wind at south-east hands employed
mending sails so ends

Wednesday Nov 30. Lat 25-35 Long 131-46
P.M. wind at North-east busy mending
sails, carpenter repairing a boat sunset
with wind at north-east course south south-
east morning wind at east north-east hands
employed mending sails saw a fin back whale

Thursday Dec 1. Lat 23-20 Long 133-56.
P.M. employed in mending light sails
washed the deck sunset with the wind
at North-east course south south-west
middle and latter wind at north-east
hands employed mending sails so ends

Friday Dec 2. Lat 21-11 Long 136-00
P.M. hands employed mending sails
made a set of pit perwarts sunset wind
at north-north-east course S-S-West
middle and latter part wind at N-East
hands employed mending sails.

Saturday Dec 3. Lat 18-56 Long 138-36
P.M. wind at N-East with squalls of
rain hands busy mending sails
carpenter at work on boat middle and
latter part strong trades.

Sunday Dec 4. Lat Long
P.M. Strong trades N-E. steering S.W. by S.
middle and latter part wind the same
hands employed breaking out water
to mending sails.

Monday Dec 5. Lat 14-36 Long 144-41
P.M. mending fore top-mast stay-sail
took in the port bowboat and put
another in her place sunset with at
east-north-east course south-west by S.
during the night wind at N-East
in the morning hauled east north-east
and remained so the rest of the day
hands employed in repairing sails
course south-west by south so ends

Tuesday Dec 6. Lat 12-18 N. Long 146-12 W
P.M. Wind from the east-north-east
course south-west by south hands employed
in sail mending, carpenter & engineer
at work on a boat. light squalls of
rain during the afternoon sunset wind
and course the same middle part wind
from the north-east with rain squalls
hands employed repairing sails and
at work in the rigging so ends.

Wednesday Dec 7. Lat 10-11. Long 148-33
P.M. fine weather and work on sails
and foot-ropes. course at sunset
south west-half south during the night
had heavy squalls of rain and
wind, morning weather the same
hands employed overhauling the
cutting block's course at half past-
ten altered the course from S-W by S.
to West-half-south.
