Thursday Dec 8. Lat 8-00 Long 155-58
P.M. strong trades and squally
course West half South during the
night strong trades morning heavy
squalls of wind and rain hands
at work on the fore top gallant and
royal foot ropes. so ends

Friday Dec 9. 1887 Lat 8-00 Long 154-11
P.M. began with fine weather
and continued so all the afternoon
at work on the cutting-guy-block
straps. course West by South sunset
with the wind at N-E. middle &
latter part a fine wind at work
overhauling foot ropes course W by
S. so ends this day.

Saturday Dec 10. Lat 8-16 Long 157-57
P.M. employed breaking out rust
Pork and hams and paint oil finish
by washing the decks course W by S.
strong trades the rest of the day
so ends

Sunday Dec 11 Lat 8-42 Long 161-23
P.M. after afternoon strong trade
wind blowing. course West by South
middle and latter part the same
took in the starboard Boat.

Monday Dec 12 Lat 8-48 Long 164-03
P.M. hands employed in the rigging and
mending sails. Carpenter at work
on the starboard Boat course W by S.
middle and latter part strong trade
winds hands employed in sail
mending and fitting the rigging
course West by South.
so ends this day

Tuesday Dec 13. 1887 Lat 8-39 Long 167-14
P.M. hands at work on sails at 6 o'clock
put the Starboard boat out and took in
the waast boat. in the night we had
strong trades morning at work on the
main-sail course West by South. so ends

Wednesday Dec 14 Lat 8-45 Long 170-47.
P.M. moderate trades at on main sail
carpenter at on the boat bent the
main sail at half past four. course
West by South during the night
a mild trade wind morning the
same at work in the main hatch
course W by S so ends this day

Thursday Dec 15 Lat 8-31 Long 173-44
P.M. at work in the after hole broke out
vinegar & paint oil. John Vigor took his
things aft in the sturage. at Capt Montross
orders. Carpenter at work on a boat
on the house. engineer at blacksmith
ing course West by South. weather was
fine during the night morning was
employed in sail patching course
West by South so ends

Friday Dec 16 Lat 8-31 Long 176-32
P.M. at on the flying bit carpenter
at work on a boat at Capt Montross
orders Godfrey Yencer began his
duties as sticrage boy. course West by
South wind was mild during the
night morning. was at work
sail mending course W by South
so ends

Saturday Dec 17 Lat 8-28 Long 178-57
P.M. finished mending sails course
West by South during the night light
trades morning the same at 11 A.M. we
hauled aback kept off at 6 A.M. so ends
