

Remarks made onboard Bk Wm Baylies

Thursday September 13 1888.

P.M. At half past two lowered all boats for whales at five returned onboard. Herald Island bears N.W. by N fifteen miles. In ships insight wind at N.E. East worked to the N.E. during the night at day light rose two whales lowered all boats at eleven A.M. returned onboard with no whale sounds.

Friday Sept 14 1888

P.M. At two o'clock lowered all boats for whales did not get any. Layed to the N.W. East at back during the night at seven A.M. lowered two boats for whales at eleven returned with no whale sounds this day.

Saturday September 15 1888

P.M. at three o'clock lowered all boats for whales returned onboard at five at six lowered again returned at eight with nothing. Layed at back at night at six A.M. kept off South East.

Sunday September 16 1888.

P.M. lowered for whales did not get any. Layed with the fore yard at back during the night at seven A.M. lowered for whales returned to the ship with nothing.

Monday September 17 1888

P.M. off Herald Island lowered for whales returned to the ship with nothing worked to the South during the night. All part employed in ships duty so ends.

Tuesday September 18 1888

P.M. Hands employed in breaking out water during the night worked to the N.E. East wind at four past one A.M. Hauled to the N.W. East at seven A.M. lowered for whales so ends.

Wednesday September 19 1888

P.M. At two o'clock returned onboard ship with nothing at seven P.M. lowered the Bk Eliza eight ships in sight working to the North West during the middle of the part of the day so ends.

Thursday September 20 1888

P.M. Herald Island twenty miles off. Hauling west saw two whales did not lower worked to the North during the night at eight A.M. lowered boats for whales. Waist-Boat got on. Cuttings in, at noon finished.

Friday September 21 1888

Light ship running to the S.E. East Hands busy clearing away the head at half past six lowered for whales returned to the ship at nine o'clock with nothing. Layed at back during the night at day light rose whales and lowered after breakfast at eight A.M. Waist-Boat struck on at nine took her along side and started to cut at twelve finished cutting so ends this day.
