

Remarks made onboard *Dr Wm Daylies*

Monday November 5, 1888.

P.M. Hands employed in Ship's duty -
wind N-N-W course East - three vessels
in sight stood to the eastward until
nine o'clock the shouting said at eleven
were ship at three were again
at eight A.M. rose the sand at
Elephant Point River for broad moon
port-beam so ends

Tuesday November 6, 1888

P.M. at four took a Pilot - at
ten o'clock dropped our anchor of
the sea wall. All well wind at west
weather clear A.M. Hands at work
hauling up Bone and Bundling Bone
so ends.

Wednesday November 7, 1888.

P.M. Ship in Port of San Francisco
Hands employed in Bundling Bone
at six finished so ends this year's
work
