

Remarks made on board Bark *Wm. Baylis*
Saturday Oct 19th 1887

Begins with light weather and breeze from the N.E. middle and latter part the same spoke the Ocean

Sunday Oct 20th 1887

Begins with light breeze and rain middle part fresh breeze from the N.E. weather hazy the Ocean and St. Mathew's Island in sight the island bearing at 3 P.M. W.S.W. distant about 10 miles. latter part, by the wind on the Port tack

Monday Oct 21st 1887

Begins with light breeze from the east at 7 A.M. raised St. Mathew's Island bearing West distant about 15 miles at 4 P.M. took in three boats latter part wind light weather thick steering S.E.

Lat 51.30 Lon 17.05 Tuesday Oct 22nd 1887

Begins with thick weather and fresh breeze from the east at 5 A.M. wind strong N.W. middle part blowing a gale from the W. steering from S.E. to S.W. latter part the same weather clear.

Lat 51.50 Lon 17.5 Wednesday Oct 23rd

Begins with light breeze and clear weather wind S.W. middle part wind baffling from S.E. to S.W. working to windward latter part the same

Lat 55.40 Lon 17.40 Thursday Oct 24th

Begins with strong breeze from the south with cloudy weather. at 11 A.M. wind hauled to the N.W. with light squalls steering S.E. latter part the same

Friday Oct 25th 1887

of Saguan Begins with strong breeze from the S.W. with boisterous weather steering S.E. middle part the same raised the island

Honau McIntosh Master

of Saguan bearing south distant about 20 miles at 1 P.M. at 5 P.M. the island bearing W.S.W. distant about 15 miles latter part fresh breeze from the west with clear weather steering S.E.

Lat 51.10 Lon 17.10

Saturday Oct 26th 1887

Begins with moderate breeze from the S.W. with clear weather middle and latter part cloudy with baffling winds from the S.W. to S.E. steering to the eastward. latter part the same.

Lat 51.05 Lon 15.08 Sunday Oct 27th 1887

Begins with light S.E. wind with thick rainy weather. at 11 A.M. cleared away with wind West. steering E by S latter part the same

Lat 50.22 Lon 16.00 Monday Oct 28th 1887

Begins with light breeze from the W. with clear weather middle and latter part the same steering E by S one vessel in sight steering to the East

Lat 50.00 Lon 16.30 Tuesday Oct 29th 1887

Begins with strong breeze from the east with rain and heavy swell middle part wind all around the compass with rain at 2 P.M. wind N.W. with partially clear weather steering east latter part the same one vessel in sight

Lat 48.37 Lon 16.40 Wednesday Oct 30th 1887

Begins with strong Westing wind with squally weather middle and latter part the same with heavy swell steering from E to E by S.
