

Remarks made on board Bark *Wm. Baylies*Thursday Nov 14th 1889

Begins with light breeze from the North.
at daylight raised the land between Point
Archa and Point Reyes distant about 25
miles bearing E. N. E. at 10 A. M. foggy at 12 M.
clear, wind light and backing at sundown
wind N. E. thick weather the land bearing
E by N distant about 25 miles. latter part
the same steering E by N.

Friday Nov 15th 1889

Begins with light airs and clear
weather at 7 A. M. spoke the tug *John*
at midday Point Reyes bearing N. E.
distant about 5 miles at 3 1/2 P. M.
took the *Guy Sea Watch* cable. At 10
P. M. anchored with the Port anchor and
30 fathoms chain so ends these remarks
and the voyage
