

Remarks Made On Board. W. B. K. W. Baylies
 Sat June 12 1890
 This day being with thick fog wind
 from W and steering S S W three
 started ice and spoke bark of same
 allen hands employed on various jobs

Sun June 8 1890
 This day being with clear weather
 and wind from N W steering W
 half N and ran to Lawrence
 island in site having it and to
 sails in site and later being foggy

Mon. June 8 1890
 This day being with fresh breeze from
 N E and being off Sant Lorançe
 island seven P M and at five
 P M spoke bark raindeer of plaber
 bay and several ships in site

Tue June 10 1890
 This day being with strong breeze
 from N E whaler loar topgails
 and storm stables and stand in
 and of at plaber bay and several
 ships anker at plaber bay under way

Wed June 11 1890
 This day being with strong breeze
 from N working to N along the
 land and at three P M wind
 died out a little and made all
 sail several ships in site

Thur June 12 1890
 This day being with wither thick
 fog with wind from N E with
 fresh breeze and laying to anker
 at ingen pint and several ships
 laying at pint to

Frid June 13 1890
 This day being with wind from N
 and thick weather and lay to anker
 at ingen pint and smoke ship

Sat June 14 1890
 This day being with thick fog wind
 from N and laying to anker at
 ingen pint and several ships to

 Sun June 15 1890
 This day being with wind from
 N and thick fog like air laying
 to anker at ingen pint

Mon June 16 1890
 This day being wind from N and
 thick fog lay to anker at ingen
 pint hands employ on various jobs

Tue June 17 1890
 This day being thick fog wind from
 N E and at nine P M logged for a
 mail but did not see him after we
 loar and at five P M clear off and
 at seven got under way and work to

Wed June 18 1890
 This day being with thick fog and
 at ten A M clear off wind from N E
 and at 10 P M wind fall to N N W
 and working to north and Sant
 Lorançe bay in site N N W distance
 about twenty miles several ships in site

Thur June 19 1890
 This day being with clear and wind
 N N W off Sant Lorançe bay at seven
 A M and some natives came on board
 and at five P M thick fog stand in
 to the land on the starboard tack

Frid June 20 1890
 This day being with fog and clear by
 spells and at four P M off big dimead
 and some natives came on board and
 wind from N and bearing N E distance
 about 10 miles lay black starb tack

Sat June 21 1890
 This day being with wind from N with
 thick fog and being off dimeads at
 seven A M and at five P M off north
 head steering E by S all sail set
 and clear by spells

Sun June 22 1890
 This day being with wind from N and
 thick fog and at eleven A M clear off
 and King island in site to work to N
