

Remarks Made On Board U.S. S. W. B. Baylies

When July 9 1890
This day being with wind from S
and anker at the coal mind hands
employed in getting coal

Thurs July 10 1890
This day being with lite air from
S and hands employed in getting
coal and several ships anker here

Frid July 11 1890
This day being with lite air from E. and
finish getting coal at seven A M and
laying at the coal mind get

Sat July 12 1890
This day being with strong breeze from
S and lay at the coal mind and
a number of ships are lay here to

Sun July 13 1890
This day being with wind from S and
strong breeze and drop our set anker
at seven A M and a number of ships laying
at the coal mind

Mon July 14 1890
This day being with strong breeze from S
laying at the coal mind with both
ankers down and at eleven A M wind
ding out a little and at one P M got
under way heading S W on the port tack

Tues July 15 1890
This day being with wind from S E.
and foggy by spells and a few fishes
work to the pint hope three ships in site

When July 16 1890
This day being with dead calm and
anford at pint hope at five A M and
got our provisions from the tom hope
and aboater header by the tom hope

Thurs July 17 1890
This day being with wind from
S E. and got under way at
five P M and steering W S W

Frid July 18 1890
strong breeze from S E. steady S W and
and ten A M laying to on starb heading E

Sat July 19 1890
This day being with wind from S E.
and thick fog and heading E. N. E.
on the starb tack loar topsails & stails

Sun July 20 1890
This day being with strong breeze from
S W and steering N E. and at twelve
steering N and at six P M anker about
six mile from shore a number of ships anker to

Mon July 21 1890
This day being with lite air from S
and laying to anker and at three
P M got under way steering N along
the land and several ships in site

Tues July 22 1890
This day being with very lite air from S.
and took our anker at six A M and
steering N along the land S anker
again at three P M several sails in site
and ice long the land

When July 23 1890
This day being with strong breeze from
S W and stand in and of from the
land at mainwight inlet and several
sails in site doing the same

Thurs July 24 1890
This day being with calm and at one
P M let air from S E. and got under way
and heading to south and westward
along the land and at three P M anker
again distance from land one mile
and half and several ships in site

Frid July 25 1890
this day being with strong breeze from
S. W. thick fog and laying to anker
between sea horses and pint bilgom
and ice in the west of us and at
three P M ding out clear by spells

Sat July 26 1890
This day being with thick fog strong
breeze from S E. and at eleven A M
wind hall to S W ice in site to W
distance about four miles of
