

Remarks On Board Bark 43. k. 11² baylies

Sun July 27 1890
This day begging wind from S W and fog and at eleven A M wind from S E and clear and about from the bar came on board of us at five A M ice in site to W of us vessel ship in situanker

Mon July 28 1890
this day being with fresh breeze S W clear and fog by spells several ships in site to anker and spoke scooper rose at four P M and she hauled off and we still lay to anker between pint. helgon and sea horses

Tue July 29 1890
This day being strong breeze from S W and drop our port anker mon night at eleven P M and hove it up leaven A M and wind ding out fast and the ice in site to W of us distance about four miles still anker between pint. helgon and sea horses distance from land three quarters of mile several ships in situanker

Wed July 30 1890
this day being with light air S E and at seven A M got under way and heading S W along the land being one mile off

Thur July 31 1890
This day being with wind from E S and got under way leaven A M heading S W and later part of the same day heading north and at five P M anker again of wainright inlet land bearing E distance three quarters mile

Frid Aug 1 1890
This day being with gail of wind from S S W and slip our starb anker at three A M and stood of shore on the port tack fog by spells and at one P M more ship and ice bearing W heading S E one ship in site to west of us and land in site to E of us distance one mile

Horace. Montrass Master

Sat Aug 2 1890
this day being with weather clear and wind from S S W and anker to west of sea horses five A M three ships in site and later part calm w rain

Sun Aug 3 1890
this day being with weather clear and foggy by spells lay to anker to N of sea horses fresh breeze from W and put the ceaganter on the starb bow in the place of vor anker we slip four ship lay to anker clear

Mon Aug 4 1890
this day being with wind from S W raining by spells laying to anker to N of sea horses and several ships lay here to

Tue Aug 5 1890
this day being with fresh breeze from S S W and thick raining at five P M wind ding out and got anker from the abram barker wain about eleven hundred pounds put it on starb bow and several ships in site to anker

Wed Aug 6 1890
this day being with wind from S E and got under way at seven A M and steer S S W along the land and at three P M wainright inlet looking for the anker we slip but could not find it and so steering W S W and to ships in site

Lat 71.35 Lon 165
Thur Aug 7 1890
this day being with wind S E and steer W S W along the ice and ice to W W of us mostly strips on ship in site

Lat 71.13
Frid Aug 8 1890
this day being with light air from S and at eight A M spoke bark game fallen and ice in site steering from S W to S along the ice and thick fog by spells

Lat 71.13
Sat Aug 9 1890
this day being with rather thick and clear spells wind from S W heading W on starb tack and at fore P M back from ice to ships in site heading
