for Nov 18th.
This day beginning with light airs
from the Southward, steering in for
the port of San Francisco.

At 8.30 took a log and at 12.00 came
to anchor in 11 fath water with Port
anchors to 30 fath chain.

Letter port lights attended, and so ended
the day.

Westerly wind Choozed Boats Crews
& Watches Letter Port Employed
getting Out Boat Gear. Letter
Port very Light wind from the
N.W. Steering S.W. By. S. Several
Sails In Sight

Sunday Nov 23rd

This day fore Port Light Air from
the N.W. Steering S.W. Letter Port
wind from the W. Steering By
the wind On the Starboard Look
One Sail In Sight

Monday Nov 24th

This day Light wind from the
Westward Steering By the wind

This day fore Port Light wind
from the N.W. Steering S.W. By
