Lat 14.14 Long 142.21
This day strong breeze steering
N. W. By N. All sail took the
Port Anchor on the bow & stowed
the chain below latter part.
Repaired the try work & took
the Starboard Bow Boat on deck

Saturday Jan 24th

Lat 16.31 Long 141.43
This day strong breeze steering
N. W. By N. All sail employed
repairing the Starboard Bow Boat
finished it and put it out on
the cranes

Sunday Jan 25th

This day fore part strong breeze
steering N. W. By N. Latter part
steering by the wind on the Starboard
Tack

Monday Jan 26th

Lat 21.04
This day strong breeze from the
N. E. steering N. W. By N. Under
topails & courses set & spoked

Lat 22.35 Long 137.24
This day strong breeze from the N. E.
steering N. W. By N. Employed doing
ships duty

Wednesday Jan 28th

Lat 23.52 Long 135.44
This day light winds from the
Northward steering by the wind
on the Starboard Tack Employed
breaking out & spoking the main
hold, fore part sleep to the men

Thursday Jan 29th

Lat 25.00 Long 132.40
This day fore part blustering strong
from the N. E. N. W. By N. Under
topails & fore sail & mainsail latter
part moderating all sail steering
N. W. half N.

Friday Jan 30th

Lat 27.10 Long 131.44
This day fore part moderate breeze
from the S. E. steering N. W. By N.
Latter part wind from the S. W.
steering W. N. W. unbent the fore
Royal & Ripped it up

Saturday Jan 31st

This day strong breeze from the
N. W. & squally lighted the Island
of Cho at day light latter part
beating through the passage

Sunday Feb 1st

This day strong breeze from the
N. steering by the wind on the
Starboard Tack at sundown the
Island of Cho Astern 30 miles off
several small Islands in sight
to the windward
