

Monday March 9th

This day strong Breeze from the N. fore Part Sailed & Large four masted Ship Latter Part Landed the Steamer Thrasher & thing since we saw her last

Tuesday March 10th

This day Blowing & Gale from the N. saw two vessels to the windward

Wednesday March 11th

This day fore Part Blowing strong from the N.W. steering by the wind in the Port Jack Latter Part Looming with the Bark Cape Horn Tiegern

Thursday March 12th

This day fore Part Light wind from the N. Mid Port Calm Latter Part Light wind from the S. Employed Repairing the fore topmast staybail & flying Rib

Friday March 13th

This day strong Breeze from the N.W. steering by the wind in the Starboard Jack saw two sails & several finback

Saturday March 14th

This day Light wind from the N.W. & Looming with the Bark Josephine saw three other vessels

Sunday March 15th

This day fore Part Light wind from the E. d. G. steering by the wind in the Starboard Jack Latter Part Blowing strong from the S. G. steering N.E. by E. the Steamer Whaling Bark Thrasher came down across our stern to speak & came near running us down carried away our signal flagboards

Monday March 16th

This day Blowing strong from the S. steering N.E. by E. At 9 A.M. took in the fore topsail & Luffed to on the Starboard Jack. At Sundown where ship still Blowing from the S. thick & Rainy

Tuesday March 17th

This day still Blowing & Gale wind from the N.W. At 9 A.M. let the fore sail fore topsail & Rib and kept off N.E. By d. wind freshened had to take in again and Luffed to At Sundown where ship on the Starboard tack with fore topsail furled

Wednesday March 18th

This day Light wind from the N.W. & fine weather steering to the N.E. Bound for the Japan Sea saw the Steamer Thrasher to Leeward of us

Thursday March 19th

This day very Light winds from the Westward steering S. by E. through the Straits of Korea, then on the Port hand & the Island of Java on the Starboard saw plenty of fish & At Sundown calm
