

Friday May 8th

This day fore Part wind from the N.E. with snow mid & latter Part the same. Saw one Steamer & one sailing ship.

Saturday May 9th

This day Light wind from the N.E. still fast in the ice two vessels in sight. Latter Part working to the Eastward through the ice with the fore & aft sails.

Sunday May 10th

This day fore Part fast in the ice mid Part the same. Latter Part working to the Eastward under short sail. Bark Triton in sight to leeward. Latter Part the same.

Monday May 11th

This day fore Part Light wind from the N. working to the S.E. 13 sails in sight. One vessel Boiling. Latter Part wind the same. Ice quite stuck working to the Eastward. 17 sails in sight.

Tuesday May 12th

This day fore Part the closing sails furled & tied up to a large cake of ice mid Part the same. Latter Part made all sail working to the Eastward. 16 vessels in sight.

Wednesday May 13th

This day Light wind from the N.W. All sail working to the Eastward mid Part the same. Latter Part tied up to the ice.

Thursday May 14th

This day Light wind from the N.W. All sail set working to the N.E. At 10 P.M. made fast to a cake of ice, & at 2 A.M. got under weigh again. At 12 A.M. tied up again to the ice.

Friday May 15th

This day fore Part Light air from the N.W. fast in the ice 10 vessels in sight mid Part the same. Latter Part made sail working to the Eastward.

Saturday May 16th

This day very Light air from the N.W. fore Part working to the E.N.E. mid & latter Part tied up to the ice.

Sunday May 17th

This day fore Part Calm tied up to the ice mid Part Light wind from the S.W. working to the N.E. Latter Part the same.

Monday May 18th

This day fore Part Calm tied to the ice three vessels in sight. One Steamer mid Part the same.

Tuesday May 19th

This day fore Part Light wind from the S.E. working to the N.W. At 5 P.M. raised whals & lowered for them the Harbord Boat. Struck a large Bowhead & sunk him two Boats on the ice & the Knight succeeded in hauling him up. At 10 A.M. lowered two Boats for whales & the Harbord Boat fastened to a large whale & at 10 o'clock got him alongside.
