N. got under weigh & stood out into clear
water One more sent up topsoil yard

the N.E. in clear water

Monday June 15th

This day Light wind from the N. Steering
By the wind On the Port Tack Repaired
the Cutting Stage

Tuesday June 16th

This day Light wind from the N.W. W
Steering By the wind On the Port Tack
One vessel in sight to the windward mid
Port Raised at least whole Lowered at Boat
But it was not worth taking alongside, Land
in sight to the N. & Lee Latter Part
working Lee in toward the Land Bark
Andrew Thicks in sight

Wednesday June 17th

This day fore Part Light wind from
the N.W. W got through the Lee steering
By the wind On the Port tack got up the
cables & got the Starboard anchor off the
Bow mid Port working tack & tack
Latter Part standing in to the Land off
Plover Bay some Bark John & Wanthrop

Thursday June 18th

This day fore Part Light wind from the
Eastward with some Rain mid Port wind
from the N.W. Latter Part the same
Beating to windward All sail three vessels
in sight

Friday June 19th

This day wind from the N.W. & clear Beating
up to windward mid Port the same

Saturday June 20th

This day fore Part Light wind from the
N. Landing with Bark John & Wanthrop
& A. Thicks mid & Latter Part wind
from the Eastward steering N.W. By, W
Latter Part made the Lee & Luffed to
the wind

Sunday June 21st

This day moderate Breeze from the S.E.
working to windward Tack & Tack mid
Port Calm Latter Part Light wind from
the N.W. steering to the S.E. trading with
the natives three canoes alongside five vessels
in sight

Monday June 22nd

This day fore Part Light wind from the
N.W. steering S.E. Along the Land mid
Port Calm Latter Part the same

Tuesday June 23rd

This day fore Part Light Breeze from the
N. steering down Along the Land to the
Eastward Natives on Board trading Latter
Part Several sail in sight Latter Part
let go anchor off Marcus Bay in 13 fathoms
off water six other vessels

Wednesday June 24th

This day fore Part Calm mid Port Light
wind from the N.W. got under weigh steering
to the N. Along the Lee Latter Part
Employed in cleaning ship Latter Part
Employed in cleaning Bone
