 This day fore Port still At anchor wind from the westward & foggy mid Port the same Latter Port got under way & worked to the S. W. In company with the Abram Barker

Tuesday Aug 18th
 This day fore Port all sail working to the N. E. Plenty of Ice off shore mid Port Lying Aback off the Ice Latter Port stood In shore & anchored In 15 fathoms water off Point Belcher 7 steamers At anchor

Wednesday Aug 19th
 This day Blowing strong from the N. E. still At anchor mid Port the same the Bark Sea Rascal Anchored here Latter Port still At anchor the steamers went to the N. 5 miles & Anchored again

Thursday Aug 20th
 This day fore Port strong Breeze from the N. E. At anchor At six P. M. got under way & stood to the S. W. In company with the Abraham Barker

Friday Aug 21st
 This day fore Port Lying Aback off the Ice mid Port the same Latter Port Lanning with the Barker & Alice Knowles

Saturday Aug 22nd
 This day fore Port left On Board the James Allen, spoke the steamer Belvedere & gave them their mail mid Port broke up the Gam. Latter Port thick fog working to the S. W. Along the Ice Latter Port Lying Aback

Sunday Aug 23rd
 This day Light wind from the N. E. Steering to the Westward Along the Ice In company with the Barker several other vessels In Light mid Port Lying Aback Latter Port working along the Ice

Monday Aug 24th
 This day fore Port Light wind from the N. E. fine weather some Plenty of walrus shot two mid Port Lying Aback off the Ice Latter Port steering to the S. W. Employed In Benching foresail & Jib & upper main topsail

Tuesday Aug 25th
 This day fore Port wind from the N. E. & foggy Lanning with the Abram Barker Linton & Boulding Billow mid Port Lying Aback off the Ice Latter Port spoke Bark Tamerlane & got twelve sacks of Potatoes

Wednesday Aug 26th
 This day Light wind from the S. E. Lanning with Abram Barker, Reindeer & Francis Burston mid Port the same Latter Port Benching sails

Thursday Aug 27th
 This day Light wind from the S. E. steering to the S. W. Along the Ice Repaired foremast stay sail and Port Lt mid Port strong Breeze steering by the wind on the Port took Latter Port Blowing at moderate Gale from the S. W. On the starboard work
