

Thursday Aug 2nd
 This day wind the same Blowing strong
 with snow squalls working to windward
 back & took mid & Latter Part the
 same

Friday Aug 29th
 This day wind from the S.W. with snow
 squalls working to windward took & took
 several sails in sight

Saturday Aug 30th
 This day strong breeze from the S.W.
 saw the steamer Jesse Freeman Captains
 from six vessels all on board the Abram
 Barker mid Part steering by the wind
 on the starboard back Latter Part
 on the Port back

Sunday Aug 31st
 This day wind from the S. strong breeze
 & snow squalls mid Part wind from
 the S.W. Latter Part Blowing moderate
 Gale working off & on the ice five
 other vessels in sight

Tuesday Sept 1st
 This day still Blowing strong from
 the same quarter working to the
 windward along the ice & other vessels
 in sight

Wednesday Sept 2nd
 This day still Blowing strong mid Part
 the same Latter Part mod moderate
 & vessels in sight

Thursday Sept 3rd
 This day fore Part wind from the S.E. &
 Clear strong breeze employed filling casks
 with salt water coming with Abram Barker
 & John & Winthrop mid Part Blowing a
 moderate Gale from the S.E. working
 through cutting the Latter Part in
 clear water

Friday Sept 4th
 This day wind the same moderating
 mid Part wind from the westward
 laying Abark outside the ice Latter Part
 working to the Westward

Saturday Sept 5th
 This day fore Part strong breeze mid
 Part the same Latter Part light wind
 from the Westward steering to the S.E.
 along the ice in company with five other
 vessels

Sunday Sept 6th
 This day light wind from the N.W. W
 & clear steering by the wind on the starboard
 took plenty of ice to windward five other
 vessels in sight - sent down fore Royal
 yard & sail Latter Part commencing with
 Bark Thoratho & A. Barker

Monday Sept 7th
 This day light Easterly wind & clear
 steering to the Westward along the ice
 several other vessels in sight
