

Tuesday Sept 8th

This day Light wind from the Eastward steering S. W. Rainy with Burk Fin on & John & another mid Port steering N. N. W. under short sail. Latter Part steering S. W. By S. Along the Ice nine vessels in sight

Wednesday Sept 9th

This day Light wind from the N. E. & fog steering to the westward Latter Part spoke the Burk Thorstein

Thursday Sept 10th

This day Light wind from the N. E. steering N. W. saw the Burk Sea Ranger take a whale sighted Herald Island Bearing S. W. 15 miles

Friday Sept 11th

This day strong Breeze from the N. E. & Rainy saw the Sea Breeze chasing whales mid & Latter Part foggy working off & on the Ice & other vessels in sight

Saturday Sept 12th

This day strong Breeze from the N. N. E. working through scattering Ice 10 other vessels in sight Latter Part working to the Eastward

Sunday Sept 13th

This day strong Breeze from the same quarter thick weather, steering to the Eastward through Ice mid Port lying back off the Ice Latter Part working to the N. E.

Monday Sept 14th

This day strong Breeze from the N. E. steering to the westward through scattering Ice saw the same Latter Part lying off & on the Ice 15 vessels in sight

Tuesday Sept 15th

This day Light wind from the Eastward steering off & on the Ice saw John & another chasing whales Latter Part spoke the steamer Balboa with 4 others the Capt. All on Board the steamer

Wednesday Sept 16th

This day Light wind from the N. W. steering along the Ice to N. & Eastward 14 vessels saw the John, P. West chasing a whale

Thursday Sept 17th

This day Light wind from the Westward steering to the N. E. mid Port backing to the S. W. up to the Ice at daylight Latter Part lying along the Ice

Friday Sept 18th

This day Light winds from the S. W. & steering to the N. E. mid Port lying back on opposite tacks Latter Part up to the Ice saw the Burk Northern Light chasing

Saturday Sept 19th

This day Light wind from the N. W. steering to the Westward spoke the Rotario & Alexander mid Port lying back Latter Part steering to the Westward Herald Island in sight Bearing W. S. W. 40 miles
