

Thursday Oct 1st

This day wind from the N.W. & fine weather saw several vessels whaling the Island in sight Bearing S.W. 10 miles

Friday Oct 2nd

This day Light wind from the Westward Steering S.E. for Port saw other vessels whaling mid Port Lying Aback Latter Port Raised at Longe whole & Lowered five Boats did not see him at going

Saturday Oct 3rd

This day fore Port Calm Raised 1 whale Lowered two Boats did not see him Again mid Port working to the Eastward Latter Port the same 14 vessels in sight

Sunday Oct 4th

This day fore Port Light Breeze from the N.W. Steering to the S.E. Along the Sea spoke the Bark Josephine & Samaritan mid Port Lying Aback Latter Port Steering by the wind on the Western tack

Monday Oct 5th

This day Light wind from the N.W. Steering to the Eastward in Company with five other vessels mid Port the same Latter Port wind from the N.E. Steering by the wind on the Starboard tack saw several vessels to the windward whaling

Tuesday Oct 6th

This day strong Breeze from the N.E. Raised whales & Lowered five Boats whales going quick to Leeward Chosen mid Port & M. And gave them gift mid Port Bunting to windward Blowing strong Latter Port moderate Lowered for whales But without success

Wednesday Oct 7th

This day Light wind from the N.E. & fine weather five Boats down chasing whales chased them in to the Sea At 4 o'clock P.M. came on board, saw the Barks Wanderer & Triton cutting several other vessels whaling plenty of whales But very wild

Thursday Oct 8th

This day fore Port wind from the N.E. Lowered fore whales going quick. But without success mid Port working to the N.W. E. young Sea making Latter Port Lowered more for whales without success

Friday Oct 9th

This day Light wind from the N.W. Lowered two Boats for a whale Only saw him once After spoke the Brig Francis Barston & heard of the loss of the steamer William Lewis At sundown Lammie the Bark Abasco Barker, Alice Henrichs, & Baywing Billow mid Port Lying Aback on Opposite tacks Latter Port strong Breeze from the N. saw two whales one Rising did not Lower for them saw several other vessels whaling
