Sunday Nov 1st

This day fore Part Blowing & moderate Gale from the S. mid Part wind hauled to the S.W. Steering S.E. Latter Part wind from the S.E. with Rain

Monday Nov 2nd

This day fore Part Light wind from the S.E. Steering By the wind On the Starboard Tack Employed In cleaning ship three sails In sight mid Part Blowing & Gale from the S. Latter Part under Cover of sails & courses Steering By the wind On the Starboard Tack

Tuesday Nov 3rd

This day Blowing strong from the S. Steering By the wind On the Starboard Tack mid Part Blowing & heavy Gale from the same quarter Latter Part moderate with wind from the S.W. Steering S.E. By E At 10 A.M. Raised & heard sperm whale Landed at Boat & took him alongside

Wednesday Nov 4th

This day fore Part Employed In cutting heavy sea Running could not do much Lashed down At dark started cutting again At daylight & got In the Body & Dark Let the Case go

Thursday Nov 5th

Lat 41.30 Long This day Light wind from the S.W. Employed In Boiling mid And Latter Part the same Steering S.E. By E. finished Boiling

This day Light wind from the S.W. Steering S.E. By E. finished Boiling mid & Latter Part Employed In Sauting down cutting & Boat Low Cross Mast & got sighted the Land At daylight - Point Arena

Saturday Nov 7th

This day Strong Breeze from the S.W. Steering S.E. Employed getting up the cables & cleaning up deck At eight o'clock P.M. sighted Point Reyes Light Bearing E. 15 miles & At 9 P.M. Farallon Light Bearing S.E. At 1.20 A.M. Luffed to with least yards Aback At daylight - kept Off Again, E.

Sunday Nov 8th

This day At 9 A.M. took the Tug Boat sea green. fueled all sail At 11 A.M. Passed Fort Point Light & At 12.15 P.M. Let go our Anchor Off the City San Francisco & ends this Voyage of the good Bark William Baylies
