

1892 Remarks from on board the Whaling. Bark

Mon Jan 11 Lat 18.03 North. Long 111.23 West
This day begins with light breeze from the NW
Middle part the same, latter part painting the two
span spars that are on deck

Tues Jan 12. Lat 17.52 Long 112.04
This day begins with light breeze from the NW
set the lower fore top sail. At sun down
saw a large Merchant Vessel heading to the E.
Middle part the same. latter part a good breeze
made all sail steaming W by N. Watch rowe
new falls to the two Bow Boats 2 to each Rope

Wed Jan 13. Lat 18.04 Long 112.55
This day begins with a good breeze from the
NNW steering W by N. Watch busy overhauling
Blocks to the Boats. Middle part the same. latter
part at day light saw Rosa Island about 20 miles off
Watch work in the Starboard Bow Boat to repair her
also overhauling Blocks

Thurs Jan 14
This day begins with a good breeze from the NNW
steering W by N with all sail set. Middle part
the same. latter part good weather. Watch rowe new
fore top sail halyards 2 to Rope and a new fall
to the Starboard and Starboard Boats and overhauling Blocks

Fri Jan 15 Lat 19.11 Long 117.02
This day begins with a good breeze from the NW
steering W by N. Watch rowe new main top gallant
Braces and Spunkies down haul. Barding 2 inch rope
and overhauling Blocks, finished repairing the
Starboard Bow Boat. Middle part the same. latter part
good weather, put the Starboard Bow Boat out
on the braces and broke out Beaf and Park
and overhauling Blocks

Sat Jan 16 Lat 19.40 North Long 119.10 West
This day begins with light breeze from the NW
steering W by N with all sail set. saw a fin back
Middle part the same, latter part being putting up the
new stay for the Mizzan stay sail.

Sun Jan 17 Lat 19.48 Long 120.55
This day begins with light breeze and pleasant weather
wind from the NW steering W half N with all
sail set. finished the stay and set the Middle stay sail
saw Greenhouses. Middle part the same. latter
part good breeze

Mon Jan 18 Lat 20.09 Long 123.03
This day begins with a good breeze from the NW
steering W half N with all sail set nothing in sight
Middle part squally, latter part good weather
Watch employed in ship duty

Tues Jan 19 Lat 20.40 Long 125.25
This day begins with a good breeze with squalls
from the NW, steering W half N with all sail set
nothing in sight. Middle part wind hauled
to the ENE. latter part wind the same. Watch busy
painting the Starboard Boat and making a yard
cut of the old fore top sail yard. William Macoy
one of the men forward was below his watch on deck
and had some words with the Capt. so we put
him in irons and down in the main hatch

Wed Jan 20 Lat NW 06
This day begins with moderate breeze from the ENE
steering W. Watch painted the Starboard Boat
nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter
part good weather. Watch busy painting the Boats
and working on the fore top gallant yard
and other ship duty
