

1892 Remarks from on board the Whaling Bk William Baylies

Thurs Feb 11 Lat-NCB Cruising off the Islands
This day begins with light breeze from the SSW
about 3 PM left off gaming and steaming N.
Middle part the same. Latter part wind shifted
to the ENE working to windward. Watch busy
over hauling foot ropes and duffs

Fri Feb 12

This day begins with moderate breeze from the
ENE working the ship to windward
saw a Steamer bound in to Honolulu and one
bound out the Island of Molokai and Waihee in sight
middle part squally, took in the main top gallant
sail. latter part a good breeze

Sat Feb 13 Lat-NCB

This day begins with a good breeze from the ENE
still working up to windward, the Islands of
Molokai and Mowee in sight. Middle part the same
latter part squally, watch busy breaking out
bread and beef and pork

Sun Feb 14

Cruising back and forth
This day begins with moderate breeze from the ENE
still working up to windward. Watch broke out
water the Islands of Mowee and Hawaii in sight
at sundown took in some of the light sails
middle part wind hauled to the SSW. latter part
good weather still working to windward

Mon Feb 15

Cruising back and forth off the Islands
This day begins with a good breeze from the SSW
working back and forth to windward saw Humphreys
middle part the same, latter part strong breeze

Tues Feb 16 Lat 2109 Long 155.19

This day begins with moderate breeze from the SSW
still working to windward took and took saw fin backs
and the Island of Mowee and Hawaii middle part
the same, latter part good weather watch busy over
hauling the foot ropes

1892 Benjer D Cleveland Master

Wed Feb 17 Cruising off the Islands

This day begins with a calm. Watch made new
upper fore top sail foot rope. the Islands of
Mowee and Hawaii in sight middle part the same
latter part a light baffling breeze steering for the
passage between Hawaii and Mowee

Thurs Feb 18 Lat-NCB

This day begins with a calm watch busy over hauling
foot ropes, made a new upper main top sail
foot rope, at sun down had a rain squall
John Hanacker is still off duty. Middle part the same
latter part a good breeze with rain for a while

Fri Feb 19

This day begins with a calm and rain, gamed
the Steamer Belvedere a while. Middle part a light
breeze. latter part moderate breeze from the N
steering Sth watch made a new fit foot rope

Sat Feb 20

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the ENE
steering SSW through the passage between
Hawaii and Mowee. the Steamer Belvedere in sight
middle part the same latter part light breeze
watch bent the new main stay sail

Sun Feb 21 Lat-NCB

This day light breeze. Gaming the Bark Alice
Knowles and Steamer Belvedere and broke out
water and filled up a cask in the ground
with salt water, middle part a calm latter part
a light breeze from the ENE steering S by W

Mon Feb 22

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the
ENE steering SSW at sun down took in the
main sail and light sails and hauled on
the wind in the port tack. John Mays and
William Moran got to fighting among themselves
and I put them in Irons, at sun down
took them out of Irons
