

1892 Remarks from on board the Whaling Bk William Baylis  
cruising off the Islands

Middle part - more ship. latter part made all  
sail with, repaired the main topmast stay sail  
Saw the Whaling Scho Brakley and 2 other sails

Tues Feb 23

This day begins with a moderate breeze from  
the S.W. heading along by the wind at sundown  
back in the light sails and layed aback  
with made another new foot rope for the fore  
land and several sails in sight. Middle part  
wind hauled to the S.E. latter part made all  
sail heading along by the wind

Wed Feb 24

This day begins with a calm with employed  
in ship duty several sails and land in sight  
At 4 PM lowered all Boats to practice the  
crews. Middle part with a calm latter part  
a light breeze from the S.W.

Thurs Feb 25

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W.  
heading along by the wind several Whalers  
and the Islands of Warhoo and Molokai and  
Humpbacks in sight. Middle part the same  
latter part a good breeze from the E and  
Came in the Black Column to Esmer

Fri Feb 26 Lat 12° 0'

This day a good breeze from the E and at sundown  
left off gaming the Islands of Molokai and  
Warhoo and several sails in sight  
Middle part wind the same. latter part strong  
breeze took in the upper top sails

Sat Feb 27

This day begins with strong breeze from the E & N.E.  
heading along by the wind the Island of Molokai and  
Warhoo and 2 sails in sight at sundown furled  
the fore and fore sail. Middle part wind moderated  
latter part good weather made all sail

Sun Feb 28 Cruising off the Islands

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the E and  
heading along by the wind. at sundown took in some  
of the light sails. Several sails in sight  
Middle part the same. latter part good weather made all sail

Mon Feb 29

This day moderate breeze from the E and laying aback  
to windward of Warhoo, several sails and fin backs  
in sight. Middle part the same. latter part strong  
breeze about 9 AM the Capt went on shore  
at Honolulu for letters. with took out water

Tues Mar 1

This day strong breeze from the N.E. the Capt came  
on board about 1 PM working to windward  
tack and took several sails in sight.  
Middle part the same. latter part made sail  
and doing the fore noon busted our fly jib and sent  
it in and repaired it. strong breeze took in the  
light sails and upper top sails

Wed Mar 2

This day strong breeze from the E & N.E. working to  
windward tack and took under lower top sails  
and fore sail and staysails, several sails in sight  
Middle part wind moderated some but the main  
top sail. latter part set the upper fore top sail  
rove new top lower fore top sail braces

Thurs Mar 3

This day strong breeze from the N.E. working to  
windward tack and took under lower top sails  
and fore sail, the Islands of Warhoo and Molokai  
and several sails and Humpbacks in sight  
Middle part wind the same. latter part moderated  
some set the upper top sails and main  
top gallant sail working to windward  
of Warhoo with employed in ship duty
