

1892 Remarks from on board the Bark William Baylies

Mon Mar 14

This day begins with strong breeze from the N.E. but the upper most top sail and fore sail still beating to windward of Union head. Middle part - the same. latter part wind at same of day light - cleared off and went into the bay and layed aback.

Tues Mar 15

Light Konaalulu

This day begins with a good breeze from the N.E. about 11 AM the Capt and Boat header Mr L. Bifford came on board, and we layed around and at 9 PM went into the bay and a boat came off with a man to go in at the shore we made all sail steering S.W. by W. Middle part the same latter part strong breeze both in the light sails. Watch busy putting the Unions into Baskets.

Wed Mar 16

This day strong breeze from the E.N.E. heading along by the wind. Watch broke out the Flop look and the Capt gave the men clothe. Middle part - the same. latter part - made all sail.

Thur Mar 17 Lat 22 30 Long 159 10 West

This day begins with a strong breeze from the E. heading N.W. by W. took in the light sails. 3 sails in sight. Middle part the same. latter part good weather made all sail. Watch employed in ship's duty.

Fri Mar 18 Lat 24. 46 Long 160. 14

This day a good breeze from the E. heading N.W. by W. with all sail but 2 sails in sight. Middle part the same. latter part light breeze wind hauled to the S.E. Watch broke out Deck.

Sat Mar 19 Lat 26 46. Long 160. 15

This day light breeze from the S.E. heading N.W. by W. with all sail but Watch sent up the Brown West. Middle part the same. latter part wind hauled to the N.E. heading along by the wind. Watch made new cutting lines. one sail in sight.

Sun Mar 20 Lat 27. 50 North Long 160. 12 West

This day begins with a light breeze from the N.E. heading along by the wind. Middle part the same. latter part wind very light.

Mon Mar 21 Lat 28 22 Long 160. 31

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the E.N.E. steering N.W. by W. with all sail but nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter part good weather.

Tues Mar 22 Lat 30 05 Long 161. 02

This day light breeze from the S.E. heading N.W. by W. with all sail but nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter part good weather. Watch sent down the main top gallant sail and repaired it and sent it up again.

Wed Mar 23 Lat 31. 36 Long 161. 32

This day light breeze from the S.E. heading N.W. by W. with all sail but nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter part wind very light.

Thur Mar 24 Lat 32 56 Long 161. 26

This day light breeze from the S.E. heading N.W. by W. with all sail but Watch broke out Water. nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter part cloudy and wind very light.

Fri Mar 25 Lat 33. 58 Long 161. 32

This day begins with light breeze from the W. heading N.W. by W. Watch broke out Deck. nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter part cloudy and wind light.

Sat Mar 26 Lat 36 00 Long 162. 53

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.E. heading N.W. by W. with all sail but nothing in sight. Middle part the same. latter part good weather. Watch made new fly jib. Bendants.
