

Nov 1

This Day began with calm fair weather Thermometer at Zero 2 a.m. at Noon 10 above Fitted a Native to Hunt Deer let him have two Dogs some of the Natives were back yesterday there having shipped their Harner and come back the most of the Dogs have a great dislike to work they will stay around the Ship all night and as soon as it gets good daylight about the time they harness them up they will go off and kick themselves and when they catch them they look a sheepish as a man would that has been caught committing some misdemeanor spend the Evening on Board of the Jerry Freeman with Capt and Mrs Cook. got home at 11 o'clock so ends this Day

Nov 2

This Day began with moderate overcast weather wind South two of the Dogs that went out with the Native Hunter yesterday came back during the night the Native came back and got his Dogs and started off for the Hunting Grounds Munger one of the Narracks Hunters got back to Dyand says he has shot 10 mountain Sheep 4 Deer and one moose. he had to give four of the Sheep to his Dogs the moose he buried in the snow but he thinks perhaps the Wolves may have eat him by this time life is very scarce on the coast & which means that has just been out with the natives and got back yesterday says that he went 20 miles inland and was gone a week a cruising about and the only life he saw was Ptarmigan or Partridges just a scene of desolation this Evening stayed on Board and tried to play the Violin but did not make a success of it Capt Penymann came on Board and spent the Evening so ends this Day

Nov 3

This Day began with a strong West S.W. Wind and overcast weather Thermometer 21 above Zero and rather disagreeable outdoors but we manage to be comfortable indoors middle & latter parts strong breeze from N.E.W. with drifting snow storm my Hunter took a luna came in with two mountain Sheep they good weight about 60 lbs dressed they good & brought the Head and Horns but the head was about half skinned for mounting it spoiled in the Evening I went on Board of the Narraack Capt Level & Tilton were there we had Candy and muric Pop Corn and Malasse Candy so much this Day some one stole some of the Thrashers Deer meat that was hanging up in the Riggings and one of her men Run away an old man 65 years of age he had been Master of a Merchant man years ago.

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This Day began with clear weather with a moderate West Wind Thermometer Five Below Zero. Went out for a walk got Lunch at 12 am on Board of Bk Womereck took a walk on shore around among the Natives. made a call on Mrs Wicks and Mrs Green Porter and Capt. Green Porter & Wicks weather fine but cool all Day

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This Day began with moderate breeze from N.E. Thermometer 11 below Zero in the Afternoon 6 the Ojibicks a Tribe of Indians the Red River I believe some say they came from the Rampart House and some from LaPere House they bring in Deer meat and a few Skins Capt Wicks man came back during the Night and although he was talking about committing suicide when they heard him on the House they thought it was some one after Deer meat they fired a Rifle at him he swung out like a good one so he was not ready to die yet a man that has been sick for three months on Board of Lehr Rogarid died today and will be buried tomorrow so ends this Day
