

January Wednesday the 2nd 1895

This Day began with good weather and a strong Breeze from the Southward. Thermometer stands 14 above and I wish it would get down where it belongs as there seems to be quite a number of cases of sickness since it has moderated I was on shore the most of the Day. in the Evening I went on Board of Northern Light to see Capt. Coogan who was sick but he only had a little cold it seems rather strange to think how many times I had overboard to two or three to Sperm whales and last night came walking out of the waist in a pair of Ice Skates

January Thursday the 3rd

This Day began with strong Breezes from the S.W. the air thick with snow an Thermometer 19 above strong Breezes all Day air full of snow I spent the Evening on Board of Narrack So Ends This Day

January Friday the 4th

This Day began with good weather and a S.W. Wind Thermometer 14 below the remainder of the Day was fine and cool at dark it was 22 below the Northern Lights were out on full Parade I spent the Evening on Board of the Thrasher

January Saturday the 5th

This Day began with fine cool weather Wind N.W. Thermometer 30 below there has nothing transpired of any moment these 24 hours

January Sunday the 6th

This Day began with fine cold weather Wind E.N.E. Thermometer 32 below Two Native Hunters came in with 17 Deer spent the Evening on Board of the Beluga So Ends

January Monday the 7th

This Day began with fine cold weather Thermometer 23 below Wind E.S.E. one of my Hunters came in with 60 Geese.

January Tuesday the 8th

This Day began with fine weather Wind S.E. Thermometer 23 below Middle & latter part fine the two men that deserted from the Thrasher came back this Evening they say that their Companion the man that deserted from the John Winthrop left them to come to the ship five days ago and that they followed his track back some little distance and then lost it so it is supposed that he is dead of course their arrival carried quite an excitement So Ends this Day

January Wednesday the 9th

This Day began with fine weather and a strong S.W. Wind Thermometer 16 below middle & latter part a S.W. Gale and I saw one of the men that came back to the Thrasher had his heel frozen

January Thursday the 10th

This Day began with good weather and a S.W. Wind Thermometer 25 below middle & latter part the same So Ends &c

January Friday the 11th

This Day began with overcast weather Wind (but) Thermometer 15 below there is not much going on at present. Billiards Cards and Coasting & Skiing So Ends &c

January Saturday the 12th

Weather but Hazy
This Day began with good Thermometer 25 below Wind S.W. I should have seen the Sun to Day but owing to the Hazy recess of the Weather we did not see her So Ends this Day

January Sunday the 13th

This Day began with a strong S.W. wind and Snow Thermometer 22 below was on Board of Narrack most of the Day and Evening
