January Monday the 28th

This Day began with a Strong Gale from S.W.
Thermometer 22 below still here strong all Day
So Ends this Day

January Tuesday the 29th

This Day began with a Strong S.W. Gale
Thermometer 22 below Thick Blowing for this
24 Hours So Ends &c

January Wednesday the 30th

This Day began with a Strong S.W. Gale
Thermometer 20 below. Mr Walker the 5th mate of
Bark Beluga has just come back from the Ramparts.
Home where he has been trading for Deer
meat it took him five Days and three Nights
to get back with 300 lb of meat So Ends &c

January Thursday the 31st

This Day began with a Strong S.W. Gale
Thermometer 22 below had a Dance and Card
Party on Board of the Horatio

February Friday the 1st

This Day began with Good Weather
inside and a strong Gale outside from
the S.W. Thermometer 22 below middle &
later Part Gale still Blowing had a Hunt
of a Saddle of Deer

February Saturday the 2nd

This Day begins with Strong S.W. Gale
Thermometer 22 below Later Part moderate

February

Sunday the 3rd

This Day began with Fine weather Wind
S.W. and Light Thermometer 23 below Later Part
Fine So Ends &c

February

Monday the 4th

This Day began with Light S.W. Winds and
good weather Thermometer 10 below good
weather

February

Tuesday the 5th

This Day began with Fine weather
Wind S.W. Thermometer 18 below Ten Ships
fitted out to Hunter and sent them out
middle & further part Fine so ends

February

Wednesday the 6th

This Day began with Fine weather
Wind S.W. Thermometer 20 below but a fine
Day. Fitted out a Hunter after Deer

February

Thursday the 7th

This Day began with Fine cold weather
Wind S.W. Thermometer 20 below at Ten o'clock
it began to snow and Breeze up
Strong Several men went out to look
for a Bear that was run yesterday
a Ship from Capt Green went out after
meat from an old Carcass to feed the
Dogs (with Fine men) one of the men
got Cold and started to come back to
the Ship at Four o'clock the Ship got back
to the Ship and not finding the man they
started a search Party that got back at Six
without success the weather being very cold
and disagreeable on account of the fine
frost flying in the air There was a party
given on board of the Treasurer in honour
of his Birth Day we had a very nice time
and kept it up until 3 o'clock in the
morning and it was Beautiful weather
with a full moon
