Thursday

March the 7th
This Day began with Stormy weather Wind
S.W. Thermometer 15 above. Blowing hard and
Snowing. Three Hunters came in with
about 1600 lb of meat To Capt & C.

Friday

March the 8th
This Day began with Strong S.W. wind
Thermometer 15 above and Snowing. Four more
Sleds came in with about 1000 lb of Deer
meat. Latter part Strong and Stormy

Saturday

March the 9th
This Day began with Good weather Wind

Died and was Buried To Capt & C.
