Freeman came Back So Ends &c

Tuesday March 26<sup>th</sup>

This Day began with fine weather  
and Blue ice has from S.W. Thermometer  
20 below Skaske a man that has a house  
on the Sami spit came up and told us that  
the Deserters had come back and come in  
to his house and as he did not want to  
us to think he was harbouring Deserters  
he thought he would come in and  
inform us Capt Cooks party came in  
with 2 1/2 Deer Reports mine as coming  
So Ends &c

Wednesday

March 27<sup>th</sup>

This Day began with a strong Gale from  
S.W. Thermometer 28 below Capt Skaske  
got in with 250 lb Deer meat Middle & latter  
part blowing

Thursday

March 28<sup>th</sup>

This Day began with strong Gale from S.W.  
Thermometer 23 below Middle & latter part  
Fine So Ends &c

Friday

March 29<sup>th</sup>

This Day began with fine weather Wind East  
Sukalinas wife went out the Day Thermometer  
18 below at 6 O'clock Charley broke Hull from  
between Decks Down the main Hatch and was  
injured so he that he died one hour  
and a half afterwards it brought great sorrow  
on all his friends and his wife is in a  
very full condition So Ends This Day

Saturday

March 30<sup>th</sup>

This Day began with fine cold weather  
Wind North Thermometer 16 below The Board  
of Capt Cooks were removed and filled with  
Salt he is to be put in the Ice House  
and sent Down in the jenny Muller and  
latter part fine So Ends

Sunday

March 31<sup>st</sup>

This Day began with fine weather  
Wind North Thermometer 16 below The Funeral  
took place at 2 P.M Service Read by Capt  
Sutton 3 Verses of Hearer to the was sang  
at the End of the Service So Ends &c

Monday

April 1<sup>st</sup>

This Day began with a strong Gale from  
the West Thermometer 26 below Middle and latter  
part fine So Ends &c

Tuesday

April 2<sup>nd</sup>

This Day began with fine weather strong  
Breeze N.E. one of Capt Cooks officers Hunters  
came in and Reports meeting three of  
the ~~Hunter~~ Deserters it is supposed that  
the other one has perished The Fearless Hunter  
got in with 350 lb Deer meat So Ends
