Wednesday May 29th

 and Ice melting Fast got our water yesterday

Thursday May 30th
 This Day began with fine weather Wind East
 Thermometer 70 above 25 tons Ballast on Board had a man
 Brought himself in some inaccountable way the
 Brought was reduced by applying Ice middle &
 latter part fine

Friday May 31st
 This Day began with fine weather Wind East
 Thermometer 70 above it is Reported that there are
 plenty of Deer to the Eastward but no Snow on
 the land and the Rivers have overflowed their Banks
 so that they are impassable

Saturday May June 1st saw the first flower
 This Day began with fine calm weather Wind
 Thermometer 70 above it is said at present engaged
 in getting ready for the coming season
