

Remarks on Board Ship Wm. Hamilton

Monday March 2^d Commences with light breezes middle and latter part the same, spoke Ship Boy of Warren 19 months out 1350 barrels hit 20 end there 24 hours

Tuesday March 3^d Commences with light breezes at 10 AM saw a shoal of Sperm Whales covered the Boats and succeeded in taking six two to the L Boat two to the L B Boat one to the waist Boat and one to the S B Boat. Took one whale to the B Mitchell eight strange sail in sight. The C M obtained 4. 10 min

Wednesday March 4th Commences with light breezes middle and latter part the same at 1 PM finished cutting on the whales and commenced boiling 10 end there 24 hours

Thursday March 5th Commences with moderate breezes middle and latter part the same at 10 AM saw Sperm Whales covered the Boats did not fasten all hands employed in Boiling 10 end there 24 hours

Friday March 6th Commences with moderate breezes middle and latter part the same at 10 AM finished boiling ten strange sail in sight 10 end there 24 hours

Saturday March 7th Commences with moderate breezes middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

Sunday March 8th Commences with moderate breezes middle and latter part the same one Boat on Shore at rock Dundee for fish 10 end there 24 hours

Monday March 9th Commences with light breezes middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

Tuesday March 10th Commences with light breezes middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

Wednesday March 11th Commences with moderate breezes middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

on a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific Ocean

Thursday March 12th Commences with moderate breezes from the S E middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there twenty four hours

Friday March 13th Commences with moderate breezes middle and latter part the same spoke Ship Shalora of Stanbuck seven months out 1000 the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end

Saturday March 14th Commences with moderate breezes from the S E middle and latter part the same at 10 AM saw Sperm Whales covered the Boats hard luck did not fasten, 10 end

Sunday March 15th Commences with moderate breezes and pleasant at 7 AM saw Sperm Whales covered the Boats and obtained one small one to the Waist Boat and cut it in 10 end there 24 hours

Monday March 16th Commences with light breezes middle and latter part the same employed in boiling at 8 PM finished 10 end there 24 hours

Tuesday March 17th Commences with light breezes and pleasant middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

Wednesday March 18th Commences with moderate breezes from the S E middle and latter part the same saw Black fish and obtained three one strange sail in sight the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

Thursday March 19th Commences with moderate breezes from the S E middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours

Friday March 20th Commences with strong breezes and rain middle and latter part the same the watch employed in saving rain water caught thirty barrels 10 end there 24 hours

Saturday March 21th Commences with moderate breezes and pleasant middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's Duty 10 end there 24 hours out of sight of the Islands
