Thursday August 6th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same the watch employed
in Ship's duty 10 ends three twenty four hours
Lat by obs 11:40 Long by alt 170:21

Friday August 7th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same at 2 P.M. and from
Island of Opoke one of the Navigators two Canoes came off
with Coconuts. The Productions of the Island are Coconuts
Bananas and Yams, 10 ends three twenty four hours

Saturday August 8th Commences with strong breezes and rain
middle and latter part the same two boats on Shore for Hogs
and yams, still lying off the Island 10 ends three 24 hours

Sunday August 9th Commences with strong breezes middle
and latter part the same two boats on Shore trading for
Hogs two men deserted Port and Canoe 10 ends three 24 hours

Monday August 10th Commences with strong breezes and
rain middle and latter part the same spoke Ship's Whistle
of New Bedford 26 months out 1600 Barrels Oil the Boat on Shore 10

Tuesday August 11th Commences with strong breezes with
rain middle and latter part the same caught the Quarten
still lying off the Island 10 ends three 24 hours

Wednesday August 12th Commences with strong breezes
middle and latter part the same the Boat on Shore trading
for Hogs and yams 10 ends three 24 hours

Thursday August 13th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same all hands employed
in getting off a raft of Water 10 ends three 24 hours

Friday August 14th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same spoke Ship's Whistle
of New Bedford 12 months out 950 Barrels Oil 10 ends

Saturday August 15th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same still in Company
with the New Bedford 10 ends three 24 hours
we have resolved partnership with the C. Mitchell

on a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific Ocean

Sunday August 16th Commences with moderate breezes middle
and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's
duty the Island out of sight 10 ends three 24 hours

Monday August 17th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same the watch employed
in Ship's duty 10 ends three twenty four hours
Lat by obs 11:20 Long by alt 173:20

Tuesday August 18th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same at 2 P.M. and from
Whale's Livered the Boat and fastened to the Main Boat
and parted the line at 4 P.M. saw the land 10 ends three 24 hours
Lat by obs 18:10 Long by alt 174:00

Wednesday August 19th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part the same the watch employed
in Ship's duty a strange Sail in sight 10 ends three 24 hours
Lat by obs 19:40 Long by alt 173:52

Thursday August 20th Commences with moderate breezes
middle and latter part strong gale took in Sail the
watch employed in Ship's duty 10 ends three 24 hours
Lat by obs 20:44 Long by alt 175:57

Friday August 21th Commences with moderate breezes
made sail at 10 P.M. from Whale's Livered the
Boats and obtained four ore to each Boat middle and
latter part strong breezes, one of the Friendly Islands in sight
Lat by obs 20:19 Long by alt 174:00

Saturday August 22th Commences with strong breezes
middle and latter part the same all hands employed
in Boating and Sailing, in sight of the Friendly Islands
Lat by obs 21:00 Long by alt 174:19

Sunday August 23th Commences with strong breezes
middle and latter part the same all hands employed in
Boating the Island of Ooko in sight 10 ends three 24 hours
Lat by obs 21:04 Long by alt 174:59
