

Remarks on Board Ship *Wm. Hamilton*

Thursday Sept. 21st Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty one strange sail in sight wind & weather still in sight of the Island

Friday Sept. 22nd Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part moderate made sail the watch employed in Ship's duty so ends their watch still in sight of the Island

Saturday Sept. 23rd Commences with strong breeze latter part rain at 6 P.M. spoke Brig Black Bird from New Zealand for Tongatabu so ends their watch
Left by 21:10

Sunday Sept. 24th Commences with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same at 6 P.M. spoke Ship Young Phoenix of New Bedford 25 months out 1900 barrels oil the watch employed in Ship's duty
Left by 21:12

Monday Sept. 25th Commences with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty so ends their watch
Left by 21:29

Tuesday Sept. 26th Commences with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same spoke Ship Jappan of Nantucket 13 months out with 1300 barrels oil the watch employed in Ship's duty wind still in sight of the Island

Wednesday Sept. 27th Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part moderate sent two Boats on shore at Ecce for Yams, seven Strange Sail in sight so ends their 24 hours

Thursday October 1st 1832 Commences with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same sent the Boats on shore at Tongatabu for Yams and Hogs the Ship Sailing off and on the Boats returned with 1500 Yams and 12 hogs so ends their watch

on a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific Ocean

Friday Oct. 2nd Commences with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Hauling Yams so ends their twenty four hours
Left by 21:10 South

Saturday Oct. 3rd Commences with moderate breeze latter part strong breeze at 10 o'clock for the Rydstadt Island the watch employed in Ship's duty so ends their watch
Left by 21:00

Sunday Oct. 4th Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty two strange sail in sight still in sight of the Island men
Left by 21:10

Monday Oct. 5th Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part strong gales with equal rain the watch employed in Ship's duty three strange sail in sight so ends still in sight of the Rydstadt

Tuesday Oct. 6th Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty two strange sail in sight so ends their 24 hours still in sight of the Islands

Wednesday Oct. 7th Commences with strong gales middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty none the too under close reef main top sail so ends
Left by 21:00

Thursday Oct. 8th Commences with strong gales middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty so ends their twenty four hours
Left by 23:10

Friday Oct. 9th Commences with strong breeze middle and latter part moderate made sail the watch employed in Ship's duty so ends their 24 hours
Left by 23:00 long by 176:20

Saturday Oct. 10th Commences with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same the watch employed in Ship's duty so ends their 24 hours
