spanker and close reef the main top sail so ended their 24 hours

Friday Nov^r 13th Commences with strong gale middle
and latter part moderate made sail ran for Backs
the watch employed in Ships duty so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 34:00 Long 178:00

Saturday Nov^r 14th Commences with moderate breeze
from the W^{SW} middle and latter part the same
all hands employed in Stowing down sail so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 33:29

Sunday Nov^r 15th Commences with strong breeze
middle and latter part moderate the watch employed
in Ships duty so ended their twenty four hours
Lat by obs 33:31 Long 178:04

Monday Nov^r 16th Commences with moderate breeze
from the West middle and latter part the same at
10 A^M spoke Ship Walmer's London 11 months out
so barrels but the watch employed in Ships duty so ended
Lat by obs 32:56

Tuesday Nov^r 17th Commences with moderate breeze
from the S^W middle and latter part the same at 1 P^M went
two boats ashore for fish the people saw a smoke on shore went
to it and found it to be a Volcano one man fell through the
Lava and burnt his foot so ended their 24 hours

Wednesday Nov^r 18th Commences with moderate breeze from
the S^W middle and latter part the same at 4 P^M spoke
Barque Governor Blount of Sydney 11 months out so barrels but
at 2 spoke the Jane of 30 tons the watch employed in Ships duty so
in sight of the French Rock

Thursday Nov^r 19th Commences with moderate breeze from the
S^W middle and latter part the same the watch employed
in Ships duty so ended their 24 hours French Rock in sight

on a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific Ocean

middle and latter part the same the watch employed in
Ships duty a strange sail in sight so ended their 24 hours
in sight of the French Rock

Saturday Nov^r 21st Commences with moderate breeze from the
S^W middle and latter part the same the watch employed in
Ships duty two strange sail in sight so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 31:01 Long 178:22

Sunday Nov^r 22nd Commences with moderate breeze from the
S^W middle and latter part the same the watch
employed in Ships duty two strange sail in sight so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 31:05 Long 178:40

Monday Nov^r 23rd Commences with moderate breeze from
the S^W middle and latter part the same the watch
employed in repairing fore sail so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 31:56 Long 178:40

Tuesday Nov^r 24th Commences with moderate breeze from the
South middle and latter part the same the watch employed
in Ships duty so ended their twenty four hours
Lat 32:50

Wednesday Nov^r 25th Commences with strong breeze from the
S^W middle and latter part strong gale from the S^W bore the
Ship two strange Close reef main top sail and fore sail so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 30:40 Long 177:20

Thursday Nov^r 26th Commences with strong gale from the
S^W middle and latter part a tremendous gale of wind with
rain took in the fore sail and mainsail stem the S^W Boat
the watch employed in Ships duty so ended their 24 hours
Lat by obs 36:54

Friday Nov^r 27th Commences with strong gale from the
S^W latter part more moderate set Close reef main
top sail all hands below so ended their 24 hours
Lat 37:20
